Justify why you chose to study abroad instead of in your home country using specific comparisons, and show strong reasons to return by linking your career goals and financial commitments back home.

2. Explain your potential circumstances in Australia.

Tip: Explain clearly why you chose this course in Australia with Holmes Institute Australia by showing you understand the Australian education system, the institute (its campus, facilities, and teaching style), and your course structure, duration, and career outcomes. Include a brief comparison with 1–2 other providers to justify why Holmes is the best choice based on evidence. Demonstrate knowledge of key subjects, skills, and how they link to your future career. Also show you understand living in Australia by outlining your planned location, accommodation, and realistic living costs. Support your explanation with evidence from course information, comparisons, and cost or housing research compared to other destinations.

3. Explain how completing the course will be of benefit to you.

Tip: Whether you are seeking to undertake a course that is consistent with their past employment and their current level of education. Tip: Any previous travels to Australia or other countries to study, travel history and the visa compliance.

5. Any other relevant matter.

Tip: Give specific details about ALL study you have previously undertaken in Australia, including when you completed your course on time, whether you completed all assessment, whether you changed courses and /or providers at any time (and explain why).
