



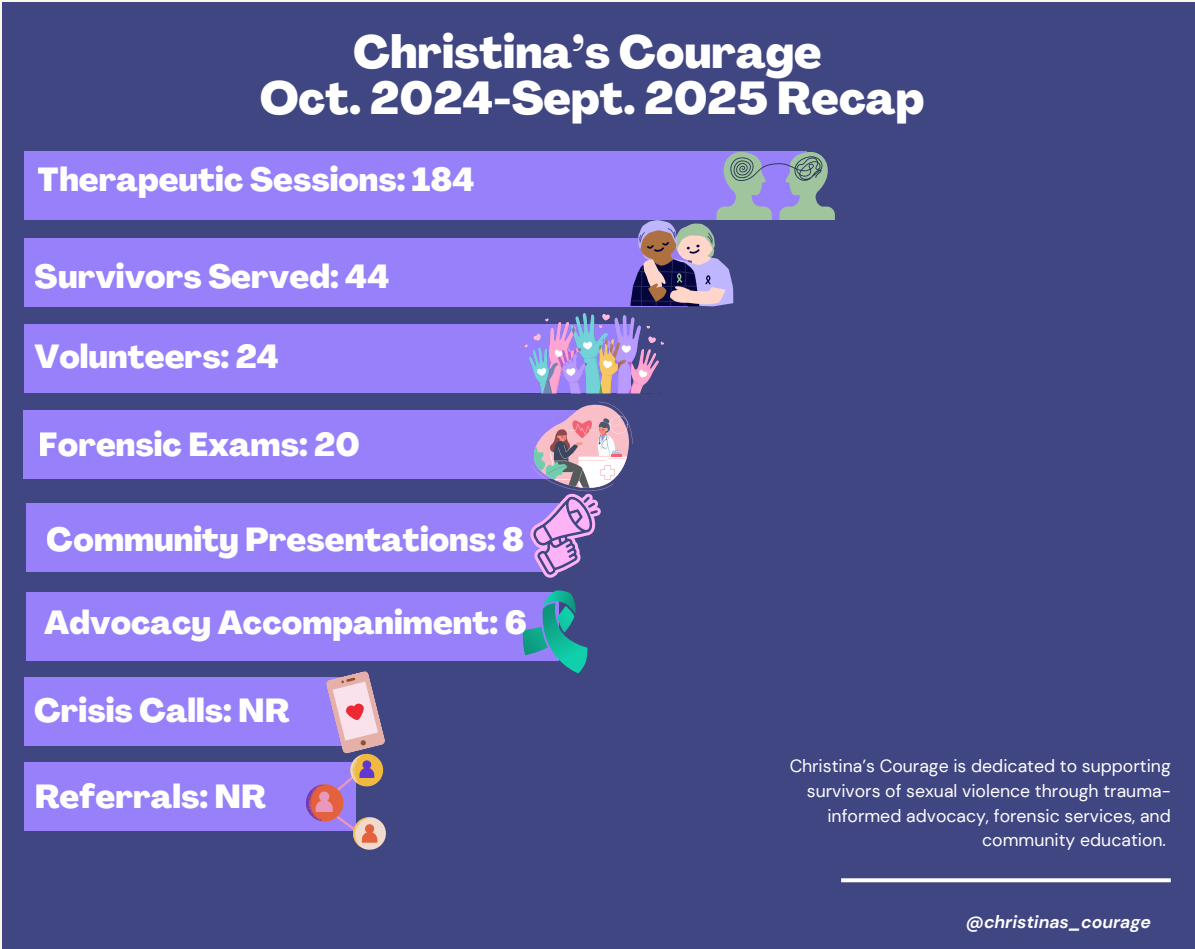
Christina's Courage
