Principal's Report

- Herusso begins to discuss College Access week at Seth Low (January 16-19)
 - Ms. Dockery's, News Crew (after school program/elective) put together a trailer for college week
 - Herusso shared video during meeting
 - Students, teachers, college representatives were featured having conversations, sharing information
 - Full coverage of college week video still in the making
 - Herusso shares specifics
 - 6th grade participated in a panel talk in auditorium on January 17
 - 7th grade attended a college fair in the 3rd floor gym on January 17
 - 8th grade will attend college visit trips this month/february
 - Herusso shares the specific dates and colleges students will be visiting
 - Colleges were chosen by students via a survey
- Old News
 - Iready (ELA and Math) at 88% student completion
 - We only have preliminary scores right now
 - Will share full scores next month after all complete
 - Community Service Projects
 - Has been incredible
 - Students, teachers, counselors thought outside the box
 - All realized how much of a difference they can make (cleaned beaches and parks, spread joy, toy drives)
 - Students picked up 50 pounds of trash
 - Students honored 62nd precinct by writing/reading them a poem
 - Raised money to save animals axolotls
 - Herusso and Amanda Smith shared pictures and information about the projects shared photos of students w/ senator, our kids were also featured in Brooklyn Eagle newspaper
- Brooklyn Nets Clinic (January 19)
 - All students were included (not a pride event)
 - All basketball kids were involved as well as students interested in athletics
 - Herusso/admin used a "wheel of names" so that all kids got a chance at being one of the 150 students to participate
- Winter Concert (January 18)
 - o Beautiful event that showcased students talents





- New Business
 - Family movie night coming up on Thursday January 25
 - Hopes that it will be just as successful as the others
 - Service projects were started in response to SEL baseline
 - In house SEL Baseline survey was administered to students in December which revealed two focus areas:
 - Self Efficacy
 - Emotional Regulation
 - Next Steps: Tailored weekly advisory lessons to incorporate regulation strategies and confidence building activities and resources
 - City Wide Student Perception surveys coming this week
 - Upcoming parent workshops (Family Support)
 - Herusso introduces "Elevate"
 - More virtual than in person
 - Explains that after the pandemic, students and adults alike need to work on engagement and social/emotional skills
 - Self reflection: What are we doing at home to make our children better students? How can we best support our children?
 - The Parent Program focuses on: Time Management, Home Study Environment, Goal Setting and Motivation, Stress Management, Beating Procrastination, and Conflict/Bullying
 - FYI: a bullying workshop will also take place for children
- Coffee and Conversations with the Principal launching
 - o There will be a survey to parents to see if morning or evening would be better for them
 - Just a conversation with Ms. Herusso informal, no pressure, an opportunity for your voice to be heard in a different way
- Herusso thanks parents for sharing their kids with her/Seth Low
- Herusso and Goddard open the floor up for questions
