Dear Seth Low Parents and Students:

This letter is to serve as formal notification of the expectations of each of your children regarding attendance and lateness. It is our school policy that we expect all students to be present every day school is in session with the exception of illness or extenuating circumstances. Our goal is for each student to have a 95% or higher attendance rate. In order for students to reach 95% they cannot be absent more than 9 days for the entire year. That equates to less than once a month. It is crucial for students to be in school and in class if we expect them to learn the necessary material to successfully meet all standards for their grade.

Additionally, all students are expected to be here at 8:00 AM every day. All students who arrive after 1st period begins (8:05 am) will be marked late and you will be notified immediately.
