This wine opens clear & nicely aromatic, with some smoky flavours along with white-stone fruit & lemon. A finessed & salty Riesling that reveals good freshness, grip & tension on the palate. Round & elegant.

18. Domaine Jean Luc Mader - Alsace AOC, France

A wine from the Mader's small 10 hectare farm set high in the Hunawihr, where the terroir is mostly clay & limestone. The wine has a fresh & aromatic bouquet with some smoky aromas. It is bottled with 33 grams of residual sugar, making the wine round & semi-sweet with good grip & a touch of minerality.

Sauvignon Blanc **ORGANIC, BIODYNAMIC**
 Sandy, chalky parcels, gives a typically fresh & effervescent wine. Minimum SO2 is used, with the wine maker relying on pH & other factors for stabilisation. The wine rests on fine lees for several months giving a richer texture.
- 20. Domaines Landron 'La Louvetrie' Muscadet de Sèvre-et-Maine AOP, France** 2020 49
(Sur Lie) Melon de Bourgogne **ORGANIC, BIODYNAMIC**
 From prehistoric ocean rocks, Jo Landron's Muscadet displays a depth of flavour & texture, & the determination of this producer to let the grapes speak of their origins without unnecessary intervention. Natural yeast & very low sulphites ensure the Muscadet we pour from the bottle is the wine Jo wants us to taste, with minerality from the soil & freshness from the fog on the Sèvre river.
- 21. Domaine Ricard 'Tasciaca' - Touraine-Chenonceaux AOC, France** 2021 55
Sauvignon Blanc **ORGANIC, VEGAN**
 Chenonceaux AOC was only created in 2011 & now produces a more opulent style with more smokiness achieved from the flinty, Tuffeau stone. 75% fermented in large oak tonneaux & 25% in smaller barrels, the oak gives texture & complexity while not overpowering the beautiful fruit. Natural yeast keeps the wine entirely true to its terroir, & grapes are hand-harvested.
- 22. Domaine Serge Laloue - Sancerre AOC, France** 2022 65
Sauvignon Blanc **ORGANIC, VEGAN**
 Brother & sister team, Franck & Christine Laloue work organically on their family farm. Practising 'agriculture raisonnée', they use no chemical herbicides or pesticides. Terroir is all important, coming from southeast facing slopes, some particularly stony, with a mix of chalk, sand & silex, & some iron rich clay. These factors give a wine of intensity with beautiful aromas of fruit & flowers.
- 23. Château de Montdomaine 'Vouvray Recolte' - Loire AOC, France** 2022 68
Chenin Blanc
 "Vouvray is Chenin Blanc, & to a certain extent, Chenin Blanc is Vouvray"
 – Jancis Robinson. Frédéric Plou's family has been making wine in the Loire Valley for 500 years. Him & his wife, Louisa's Vouvray, is a delightfully expressive wine with great balance & lovely acidity. It has a delicate pale yellow appearance that leads you to a nose of light citrus followed by stone fruits & white flowers.
- 24. Domaine Jousset 'Premier Rendez-Vous' - Vin de France** 2021 88
Chenin Blanc **ORGANIC, BIODYNAMIC**
 "Our First Meeting". This wine is hand-harvested from vines up to 70 years of age, the grapes are naturally fermented & aged in 8-year-old 500-litre barrels, for eight months so the wine can interact with air. Very delicate fining leaves a mind-blowingly good wine. Round & rich with white flowers, a hint of grass & stone fruit & a very long finish.

- 25. Château Haut-Garriga - Bordeaux AOC, France** 2022 30
Semillon **ORGANIC, VEGAN**
100% Semillon fermented in stainless steel tanks & is temperature-controlled to protect the natural aromas from oxidation. Ageing on fine lees for three weeks. A wine that is bright & full of citrus & grapefruit, developing into zingy lemon curd & a very long finish.
- 26. Château Thieuley 'Les Truffières' - Vin de France** 2019 54
Chardonnay
In 2007, Château Thieuley decided to plant Syrah & Chardonnay (two varieties forbidden to produce Bordeaux AOC). & just next to them, Francis Courselle, a great fan of truffles, grew more than one hundred truffle trees on a soil said to be adapted to them. Hence, the name Les Truffières. This characteristic top-class Chardonnay is a yellow-bright colour showing good minerality with flavours of almonds & honey. A very round mouth with a lot of richness & good persistence.

France - Beaujolais & Burgundy

- 27. Domaine de Terres Dorees, Roussanne Blanc - Beaujolais Blanc AOC France** 2021 54
Roussanne **ORGANIC**
Vines were planted in 2000 on clay-limestone soils. Farmed organically & harvested by hand. The whole clusters are pressed & fermented in a cement tank with a pied de cuve (the winemaking version of a sourdough starter) & fruit from the vineyard. The wine undergoes malolactic fermentation & is aged on lees in the tank with regular bâtonnage.
- 28. Domaine Christean Moreau, Chablis AOC, France** 2022 65
Chardonnay **ORGANIC, VEGAN**
Made from old vines from the left bank of the Serein River, in the heart of Chablis, on calcareous clay. Hand-harvested & sorted in the winery with fermentation in stainless steel tanks with ten months on lees. This is a classic Chablis with oodles of stone fruit & flint made by an iconic producer.
- 29. Jean Thevenet, Domaine de la Bongran - Vire-Clesse AOC, France** 2019 95
Chardonnay **ORGANIC, VEGAN**
This is a legendary vineyard yet just 4.5 hectares. Using late harvest, the juice has an extended fermentation & time on lees for up to two years & further years in bottle. The Thévenets do not release without a minimum of two years bottle age. With a hint of botrytis richness & zingy crispness, it retains mellow autumnal flavours. This wine has an unreal complex length.
- 30. La Soufrandière Climat 'Les Quarts' - Pouilly-Vinzelles AOC, France** 2021 125
Chardonnay **ORGANIC, BIODYNAMIC, VEGAN**
The earth here is soft, aerated & smells of liquorice. The Climat 'Les Quarts' is undoubtedly the best of appellation Pouilly-Vinzelles. The almost magic position of the South-East facing, 40 to 68-year-old vines of Chardonnay, plus the living clay & limestone soil. It is a great Burgundy wine with a citrusy mineral nose, well-balanced & complex with a richness in the mouth.

- 31. Weingut Steininger - Kamptal DAC, Austria** 2022 44
Grüner Veltliner **ORGANIC**
Steininger is genuinely a family winery, with Eva starting to take over from her father Karl & mother Bridget. The Steiniger's Grüner is grown mostly in loose soil, benefits from very warm days, & cool nights resulting in a wine with incredible aromatics. A wine with richness & brilliant freshness.
- 32. Weingut Brandl 'Zöbing Terrassen' - Kamptal DAC, Austria** 2022 52
Riesling **ORGANIC**
This is a beautiful Riesling owing its uniqueness to the primary rock terroir of the terraces where it's grown. It makes the most of the valley's exposure & cooling winds. The extremities of temperatures can peak at 39°C in the day & fall to 15°C in the evening, creating a wine with brilliant aromatics. Hand-harvested & fermented in stainless steel tanks, leads to a very fragrant nose. On the palate, it is exotic & lively with classic stone fruits, ripe apricots, & a smooth minerality on the finish.

Germany

- 33. Bender 'Paulessen' - Mosel QBA, Germany** 2020 42
Riesling **ORGANIC**
Andreas believes in making wine that he likes. This wine is not a traditional Mosel as it blends all of his parcels on the steep slate slopes of the Mosel river. Organically farmed & hand-harvested, the wine is fermented spontaneously in 60-year-old 600-litre oak barrels & then three months in stainless steel for clarification. This gives a bone dry wine, with ripe apricot & sweet Golden Delicious apples, & a lean mineral edge. The finish is long, with thrilling mixed orchard fruits.
- 34. Bender 'I Love Mosel' - Mosel Kabinett QMP, Germany** 2021 48
Riesling **ORGANIC**
Andreas made a wine that they enjoy drinking in the Mosel, from a single parcel of red slate in the Premier Cru vineyard Schweicher Annaberg site. Hand-harvested & spontaneously fermented in large old oak barrels, before a temperature-controlled ferment, resting on lees for three months in stainless steel tanks. Off-dry with honeyed fruit that is framed by mouthwatering, crushing freshness.
- 35. Bender Weißburgunder - Mosel QBA, Germany** 2021 49
Weissburgunder (Pinot Blanc) **ORGANIC**
The German for Pinot Blanc is not as we know it. From the slate slopes of the Mosel, organically grown, hand-harvested before spontaneous fermentation in large old oak barrels before time in stainless steel. Pear & very ripe mango, with a mixed orchard of aromas. A superb marathon-length finish.

- 36. Pessoa Da Vinha 'Summer Wine' - Vinho Verde DOC, Portugal** 2022 35
Loureiro **ORGANIC, BIODYNAMIC, VEGAN**
This is Vinho Verde but not as you know it. Jorge Gonçalves learned his winemaking in Germany. So when he returned home to Portugal with his sommelier wife Livia Novais, they decided to make Vinho Verde but single varietal Loureiro & make it Kabinett style. Fermented in stainless steel tanks it is the first wine of the summer. Perfectly balanced between sweetness & freshness, lively & elegant.
- 37. Crasto - Douro DOC, Portugal** 2021 42
Viosinho, Rabigato, Gouveio **ORGANIC, VEGAN**
This is the Chablis of the Douro. From a careful selection of 40% Viosinho; 30 % Gouveio; 30% Rabigato. Hand-harvested & fermented in stainless steel tanks, with prolonged time on lees resulting in a very fresh & fragrant modern style of wine. On the nose, grassy aromas along with citrus & asparagus. A wine with an extraordinarily fresh, crisp, & pleasant palate.

- 38. Bodegas Langa 'Señorío de Ayud' - Calatayud DO, Spain** 2022 28
Macabeo **ORGANIC, VEGAN**
From the 5th generation winemaker Cesar Langa. Organically grown fruit In Calatayud at 600 metres above sea level. Hand-harvested, fermented in stainless steel tanks under temperature control. There is no malolactic fermentation keeping the wine fresh & zingy — peach flavours with a bite of acidity at the end.
- 39. Neleman 'Bike Collection' - València DO, Spain** 2022 34
Viura, Merseguera **ORGANIC, BIODYNAMIC, VEGAN**
This white wine is so refreshing that it gives you a boost! Relatively unknown Valencian grape Viura Merseguera, is lemony-juice and pear-like-fruity, it's a super fresh, zesty and light white wine.
- 40. Bodega Crego e Monaguillo – Monterrei DO, Spain** 2022 38
Godello, Treixadura **ORGANIC, VEGAN**
Galicia is most famous for its Albariño in Rías Baixas. Further inland, following the northern border of Portugal, you find Monterrei and Godello where the Rodriguez family farms 55 hectares. It is 90% Godello and 10% Treixadura and harvested up the hills at 600 metres above sea level. The wine is gently pressed and racked into stainless steel tanks, where fermentation is temperature controlled. The result is a very well-balanced wine under rich texture and purity of apple, pear and melon — zesty finish.
- 41. Atlantik - Rías Baixas DO, Spain** 2022 42
Albariño
This is the second label wine from the iconic Fillaboa estate. Vines are grown using the Pergola method on stony clay soil right up to the banks of the Té & Miño rivers. Single site, hand-harvested, gently pressed & fermented using indigenous yeast & left on lees for an extended period. This is a steely crisp wine, apple & citrus with a modern structure to the end.

The vines are hand-harvested & grapes cold macerated for 12 hours then racked into stainless steel & fermented using their own cultured yeast. Extended times on lees leads to a rich, well rounded, fresh wine, with good length.

43. Guerinda 'La Roya' - Navarra DO, Spain

Garnacha Roya **ORGANIC, BIODYNAMIC, VEGAN**

Garnacha Roya is the local name of the indigenous Grey Garnacha. La Roya is a full-bodied white with a little tannin on the palate and beautiful tension. On the nose it is light and fine. It has citric and stone fruit (apricot) aromas; dried flower notes and subtle aniseed hints. Lingering, vibrant and mineral finish. A wonderful gastronomic wine.

44. Fillaboa - Rías Baixas DO, Spain

Albariño **VEGAN**

From a single vineyard site, on the hillside overlooking the Té river, where the mist rolls in from Portugal as the morning sun hits the cold river. The vines are trained using the Pergola method, to protect the grapes from mildew. Hand-harvested then fermented in stainless steel tanks using indigenous yeasts. With scents of apricot & honey on the nose, before the mouth-watering acidity & citrus flavours take over the palate. Well balanced with a beautiful richness. This is why Fillaboa is one of Spain's iconic wines.

- 108. Domine Chandon de Briailles, Corton Grand Cru 'Les Bressandes' AOC, France** 2021 490

Pinot Noir **ORGANIC, BIODYNAMIC, VEGAN**

The vineyard is between the villages of Aloxe-Corton & Ladoix. Its red clay soil & southeast-facing slopes on the hill of Corton just at the beginning of Côte de Nuits gives the power of Côte de Nuits with the elegance of Beaune. The soil is dense like bedrock, so the vines need to work hard. 70% stemmed to 30% destemmed. This wine is alive with a lovely balance & great length on the palate, complex with some secondary flavours kicking in, unusual for only two years old. This wine is wonderful yet serious.

- 109. Weingut Wellanschitz - Burgenland DOS, Austria** 2022 46

Blaufränkisch **ORGANIC, VEGAN**

The vines are grown in slate, orthogneiss & limestone. Hand-harvested & sorted before pressing & undergoing natural fermentation for ten days in stainless steel. The extended maceration is aided with the use of an air pump. Malolactic fermentation takes place before ageing in 1,200 litre wooden casks — a terroir-driven wine with aromas of black cherry & blackberry & a soft spicy finish.

- 110. Weingut Wellanschitz - Burgenland DOS, Austria** 2022 44

Zweigelt **ORGANIC, VEGAN**

This is a brilliantly hardy grape that Dr. Zweigelt created for the Austrian climate. These vines are grown in the dolomite foothills of the Alps. Hand-harvested & grown organically. Spontaneous fermentation takes place in stainless steel tanks, using the punch down cap method. The wine is racked & then aged for 12 months in 1,200-litre wooden casks. The result is a medium-bodied wine with warm dark blackberry fruit balanced by Alpine freshness.

- 111. Bender - Pfalz QBA, Germany** 2020 48

Pinot Noir **ORGANIC**

Growing up in the Mosel, it is only natural that one of Andreas' loves is Pinot Noir (or Spätburgunder as the Germans call Pinot Noir). Grown organically in Pfalz, the fruit is transported to the winery in his home village of Leiwen where it undergoes spontaneous fermentation & is aged in a mixture of stainless steel tanks & oak barrels. This wine is an excellent example of Spätburgunder with charming aromas of red fruits & on the palate, blackberry, spice & cedarwood, ending in a spicy clove finish.

- 112. Weingut Kolfok 'Querschnitt' - Burgenland DOS, Austria** 2021 59

Rotburger, St Laurent, Blaufränkisch, Syrah **ORGANIC, VEGAN**

The word Kolfok has its origins in a regional dialect & describes a younger person who does not toe the line or swims against the tide. Old Rotburger vines were still grafted on their own rootstock. St. Laurent, Blauburger & Blaufränkisch with a touch of Syrah. Fermented with natural yeast in large oak barrels. Blackcurrant with a hint of cinnamon. Intense black forest fruit at the end.

- 113. Flor de Crasto - Douro DOC, Portugal** 2021 34
Tinta Roriz, Touriga Franca, Touriga Nacional **ORGANIC, VEGAN**
A young wine from the famous port house, Quinta do Crasto. Violet in colour, the nose presents fresh aromas of wild Douro fruits. It is very well integrated with elegant floral notes. On the palate, it starts in a captivating way, evolving to a medium structured wine, with good volume & silky tannins. An attractive wine that ends balanced & with pleasant sensations of freshness.
- 114. Quinta das Maías - Dão DOC, Portugal** 2021 38
Mencia, Touriga Nacional, Alfrocheiro **ORGANIC, VEGAN**
The Lourenço family are considered by many to lead the way in winemaking in the Dão. Their vineyard is now a registered organic estate, & their wine is grown high in the mountains on granite soil. Maías is the local name for the Weaver's Broom plant, which surrounds the estate here. This wine is more akin to a Beaujolais Cru. Soft, succulent red fruit, crème de cassis, a splash of cream, savoury dried herbs, & deeply refreshing acidity; we love this slightly chilled with barbeques, light lunches, etc. Mediterranean or Middle Eastern fare.
- 115. Crasto Superior - Douro DOC, Portugal** 2019 50
Touriga Nacional, Touriga Franca, Tinta Roriz, Souzão **ORGANIC, VEGAN**
This wine takes its name from the location of the vineyard from which the grapes come: Douro Superior (Upper Douro). Crasto Superior is fresh & balanced on the nose. Fresh on the palate, great body & ripe firm tannins. Very complex notes of dark berried fruits, gum cistus & cocoa linger towards the elegant finish. Excellent length.
- 116. Quinta do Crasto Reserva Old Vines - Douro DOC, Portugal** 2020 85
Old Vines (Field Blend) 25-30 varieties, mixed plantings **ORGANIC, VEGAN**
Made from 70-year-old vines, this is a true field blend & reflection of terroir. Once fermentation is complete in the steel tanks, the fruit is gently pressed, then racked into oak barrels — 85% French & 15% American for 18 months. The wine has red fruit notes & hints of wild berry with an elegant beginning, evolving into a wine with power & complexity.

Spain

- 117. Bodegas Pagos de Araíz Joven – Navarra DO, Spain** 2021 28
Tempranillo, Garnacha **ORGANIC, VEGAN**
After harvest, grapes are destemmed & fermented in stainless steel under Temperature control, with maturation on skins for at least seven days. Vines are low yield which gives us a deep flavoured & very enjoyable wine.
- 118. Bodegas Olivares 'Altos de la Hoya' - Jumilla DO, Spain** 2020 34
Monastrell **ORGANIC, VEGAN**
The Olivares family own ungrafted bush vines, planted in the 19th century pre-Phylloxera. Planted at 825 metres above sea level, with warm days & cool nights. Hand-harvested & fermented in stainless steel tanks on skins, with wild yeast, & aged for six months in a mixture of 225-litre French oak barrels & 60-litre oak tanks. Deep ruby in colour with powerful scents of red & dark fruits, minerals & spices. A long finish with dark fruit notes.

We chose this Amarone from Pier Paulo Antolini for its elegance. Yes, it's full-bodied & rich, but with balancing acidity & soft tannins, due to the position of the vineyards, pergola planting to avoid over-ripeness, & great care in the natural drying of the grapes.
- 134. Silvano Bolmida 'Barolo Riserva' - Barolo DOC, Italy** 2016 159
Nebbiolo **ORGANIC, BIODYNAMIC**
A simply sensational & classic Italian Barolo. Made only from selected parcels of outstanding quality Nebbiolo grapes, this rich yet elegant wine is only released 5/6 years after harvest & will age amazingly well for up to 20 years.

- 135. Kamara Pure 'Nimbus' - Thessaloniki PGI, Greece** 2020 64
Xinomavro, Merlot, Syrah **ORGANIC, BIODYNAMIC, VEGAN**
Xinomavro or "black sour" is a big grape with characteristics of the Nebbiolo variety. Dimitrios, after studying at the University of California Davis could see the potential of softening this powerful grape with Syrah & Merlot. Both Syrah & Merlot are vinified together, with Xinomavro being fermented by itself. Blended after ferment & aged in oak barrels for 12 months, leaving us with a big intense ruby wine, with flavours of blackberries, plum, cracked black pepper & a hint of spearmint.

Romania

- 136. La Sapata - Podgoria Sarica Niculitel DOC, Romania** 2022 40
Babeasca Neagra **ORGANIC, BIODYNAMIC**
Babeasca Neagra meaning "Grandmother's black grape", is a late-ripening variety & therefore less-prone to damaging spring frosts. It is grown organically, then fermented with natural yeasts in temperature-controlled stainless steel tanks & macerated with skins for 10 days. Fruity aromas with hints of Morello cherry. Well-integrated & velvety with a fruity aftertaste & a very long finish. A real wow wine.

Roca is a family affair with some of the Malbec grapes over 60 years old. The vineyards are at 700 metres above sea level, with a permanent breeze & cool nights giving this wine complexity & balance, not over-baked, with the Merlot adding a nice touch of ripe plum fruitiness.

Five per cent of Bodini's profits are donated to charities in Mendoza, including the Susana Balbo Wines Scholarship Foundation dedicated to providing education opportunities to winery worker families throughout Argentina.

- 155. Château Haut Rian 'Les Vignes de Coulous' (750ml) - Cadillac AOC, France** 2021 52
Semillon, Sauvignon Blanc **ORGANIC**
Grown on the bank of the Garonne opposite the legendary Sauternes appellation, Château Haut Rian benefits from the same "botrytising" river mists as Sauternes. In the glass, this wine has rich marmalade sweetness with zippy hints of orange peel and lemon zest.
- 156. Accordini (500ml) - Recioto della Valpolicella Classico DOCG, Italy** 2020 75
Corvina, Corvinone, Rondinella **ORGANIC**
Selected grapes, naturally dried for up to 4 months, some grapes being affected by noble rot, then fermented with indigenous yeast until the exact sweetness and flavours have been achieved. At this stage, the yeast is removed to stop fermentation, and the wine is then aged in oak for several months. This wine was the precursor to Amarone, which came about by mistake when someone forgot to remove the yeast.

- 157. Quinta do Crasto Late Bottled Vintage Port - Douro DOC, Portugal** 2016 60
Tinta Barroca, Touriga Franca, Tinta Roriz, Touriga Nacional **ORGANIC**
5 years in oak barrels have softened the tannins and allowed the scents and flavours to blossom in this LBV port. It is elegant with succulent red fruit flavours and a subtle spicy character. Intense yet accessible, this is enduringly indulgent.
- 158. Quinta do Crasto Vintage Port - Douro DOC, Portugal** 2018 125
Tinta Barroca, Touriga Franca, Tinta Roriz, Touriga Nacional **ORGANIC**
Inky black and opaque, Quinta do Crasto Vintage Port has an aroma of ripe dark fruit with an elevated herbal top note. On the palate, there is a flawless balance between freshness of the fruit flavours and the intense and complex notes of mineral, smoke and graphite.
