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OPPOSED HCR 2040/PROP 143

Governor Hobbs publicly opposed HCR 2040/Prop 143, and supported a bipartisan deal to remove HCR 2040 and keep Arizona communities safe.



SIGNED BILL TO GIVE ARIZONA ACCESS TO MORE FIRE FIGHTER RESOURCES

In May of 2024, Governor Hobbs signed HB 2751. Which gives Arizona access to a larger pool of firefighting resources— including equipment and personnel. Helping to combat the growing wildfire threat across the state, and help fire fighters.



PFAS REDUCTION FOR FIRE FIGHTERS

Governor Hobbs signed bill to further reduce the exposures of fire fighters to PFAS chemicals. Helping fire fighters reduce their exposure to cancer causing chemicals.



OCCUPATIONAL CANCER SUPPORTER

Governor Hobbs signed the 'comma bill' into law, helping to cover fire fighter occupational cancer claims. Solidifying her stance on protecting fire fighters when they contract occupational cancer.



SECURING FUNDS FOR WILDFIRE SUPPRESSION EFFORTS

Governor Hobbs, with bipartisan support, secured ten-million dollars for wildfire suppression efforts. Reinforcing her stance on supporting fire fighters, and protecting Arizona from wildfires.



MENTAL HEALTH SUPPORT FOR PUBLIC SAFETY

Governor Hobbs signed into law and extension of the Craig tiger act. Allowing fire fighters and public safety personnel access to mental health treatments.



INCREASED LODD STATE BENEFITS FOR FIRE FIGHTERS

Governor Hobbs signed Senate Bill 1503, which provides an additional \$250,000 benefit from the state for any first responder killed in the line of duty.



FIRE DISTRICT FUNDING

Governor Hobbs secured 4 million dollars for rural fire districts across the state. The first of its kind to combat the fire district funding problem.
