The museum also holds unique treasures such as the only perspective box in the Netherlands and rare works by Matthias Stomer.

During this exclusive Sparkling Art Matinée, you will enjoy a personal guided tour by the curator, who will share insights and stories about this intimate and historically rich collection.

Sparkling wine will be available throughout your visit, making it the perfect way to toast art, culture, and togetherness, and an ideal prelude to the ball later that evening.



