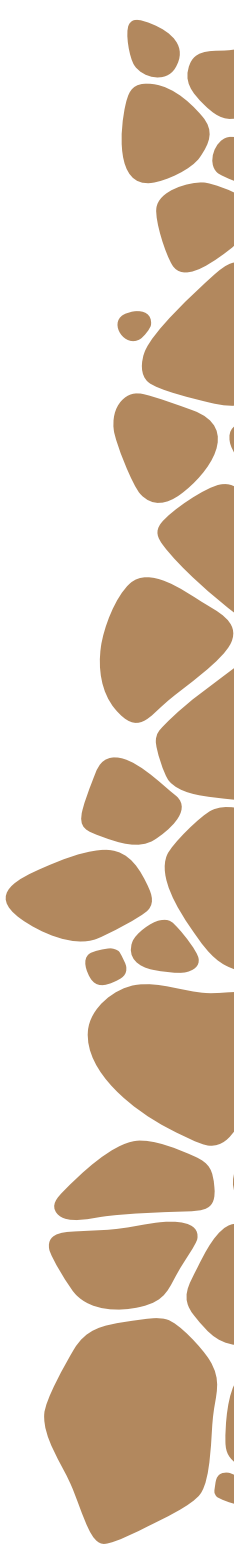

Rental performance varies with season, typology, and occupancy. Comparable properties on Zanzibar's north coast achieve occupancy of 65–75% in established operations, with nightly rates ranging from \$180 to \$450 depending on villa size and configuration. 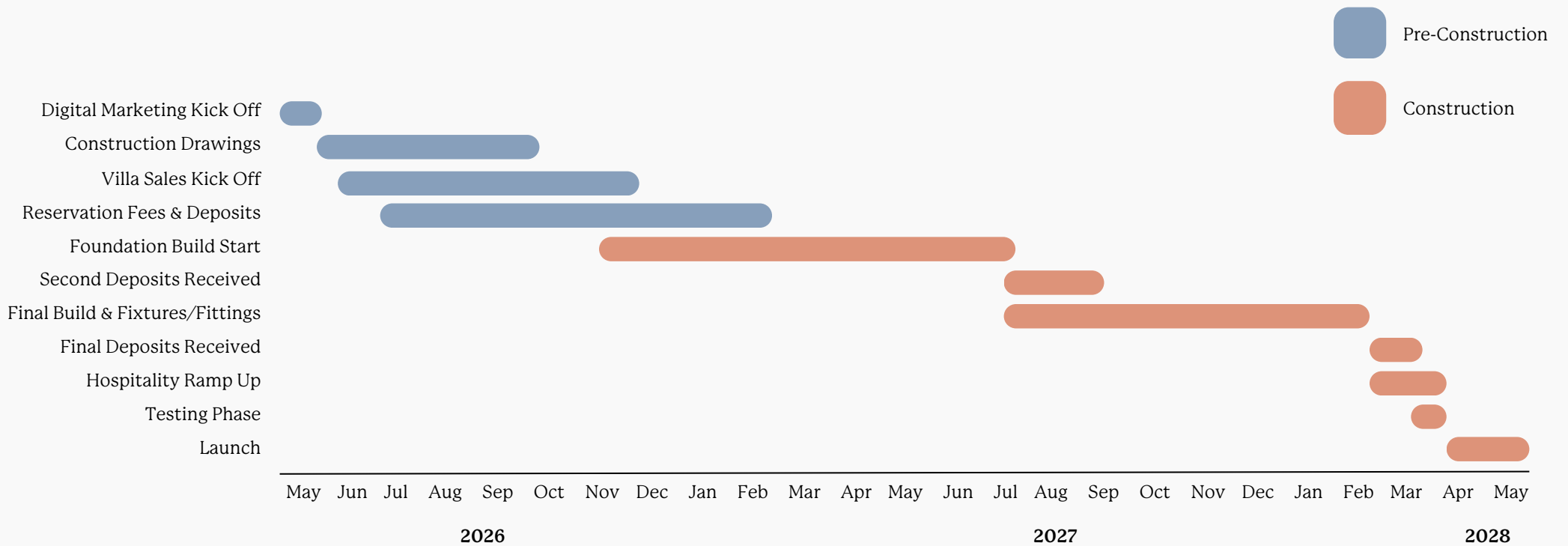

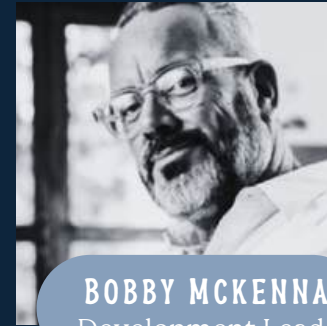
