



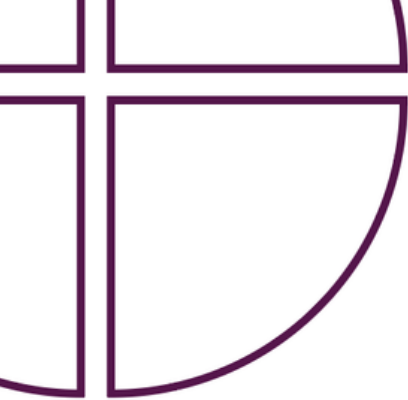


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How Tuition Fees Works

Understanding Our Fees, Discounts & Payment Plans

Choosing the Right Payment Plan

At Maple Bloom, we offer flexible payment options to support families while maintaining transparency and clarity.

Families benefit from the lowest tuition rates when selecting the Annual Payment Plan.

Instalment plans are available for flexibility and include a small administrative loading compared to the annual payment option.

Late payment may result in the withdrawal of applicable discounts, temporary restriction of services, or withholding of academic reports until accounts are brought up to date.

Choosing Between Standard and Prime

- Standard covers the core academic school day. Supervision beyond the standard dismissal time is charged separately where applicable.
- The Prime Programme is Maple Bloom's extended-day enrichment programme offered after the core Standard school day. Families may:
 - enrol for the **full term** (recommended and more cost-effective), or
 - request participation on a **daily or weekly basis** where space is available.

Estimated Annual Cost Overview

Tuition fees vary by year group and payment plan.

In addition to tuition, families should expect:

- Registration Fee (one-time at entry)
- Enrolment Deposit (refundable upon final exit)
- Re-Enrolment Deposit (credited toward the first instalment each year)
- Capital Development Levy (Primary & Secondary only)
- Books and Learning Materials (vary by year group)
- Uniforms
- Transport (optional)
- Trips, events, and external examinations where applicable

Available Discounts

5% Sibling Discount

The Sibling Discount applies to tuition fees only and is applied to each enrolled sibling. This discount cannot be combined with any other promotional offer.

Discount Policy

Promotional offers (including campus launch incentives) cannot be combined unless explicitly stated.

The Annual Payment Plan represents the standard tuition rate. Instalment plans include a small administrative loading for added flexibility.

Frequently Asked Questions

Q. Can I change my payment plan during the year?

A. Payment plans are selected for the full academic year and cannot be changed once invoices have been issued.

Q. Which payment plan offers the best value?

A. The Annual Payment Plan (Plan A) offers the lowest total tuition. Instalment plans provide flexibility but at a higher overall cost.

Q. Who can I contact for clarification or support?

A. Our Finance Office and Front Office teams are always available to guide you through the process and help you select the most suitable option.

The Prime Programme is Maple Bloom's extended-day enrichment offering. Families may enrol for the full term or select flexible participation options (daily or weekly) where available.

The Prime Programme is Maple Bloom's extended-day enrichment programme and talent development programme, created to nurture children's creativity, confidence, and skill in a fun and structured environment. Running every afternoon during regular school days, Prime Club is open to all children aged 1 to 15, including non-Maple Bloom students.

A Diverse Programme Across 3 Categories:

- **Skill:** Arts & Crafts, Drama, Pottery, Coding, Scouts, Chef's Club
- **Language:** French, Swahili, Chinese, English (EAL)
- **Sports & Fitness:** Taekwondo, Tennis, Gymnastics, Football, Basketball, Zumba, Swimming, Skateboarding ...and many more!

Each session is led by qualified facilitators and a light snack and refreshment is served daily.

Fees Policy



1. Fees Policy

- 1.1 This Fees Policy outlines the structure, expectations, and procedures relating to school fees at Maple Bloom.
- 1.2 Tuition fees are based on an annual fee structure representing the full academic year.
- 1.3 By enrolling, parents commit to the full academic year or the remaining portion of it.
- 1.4 Instalment plans are offered as a payment convenience and represent alternative pricing options, with increased flexibility resulting in a higher total fee compared to the annual payment option.
- 1.5 The annual payment option provides the most favourable rate, and families are encouraged to select this option to benefit from the lowest overall tuition cost.

2. Registration, Enrolment & Deposit

- 2.1 A non-refundable registration fee of TZS 2,000,000 per child is payable at enrolment.
- 2.2 A refundable deposit of TZS 2,000,000 per family is required at enrolment and is subject to the terms outlined in Section 3.
- 2.3 Enrolment is confirmed only upon receipt of all required payments.
- 2.4 All non-tuition fees, including Capital Development Levy, learning materials, and any other applicable charges, are payable in full at enrolment and are non-refundable unless expressly stated otherwise.
- 2.5 Enrolment is continuous unless formally withdrawn in accordance with this policy.

3. Mid-Year Enrolment

- 3.1 Mid-year tuition is based on the full annual tuition fee under the annual plan and is structured to reflect the increased cost of mid-year entry.
- 3.2 Entry bands:
 - 3.2.1 On or before 30 September → 100%
 - 3.2.2 1 October to 30 November → 85%
 - 3.2.3 1 December to 31 January → 70%
 - 3.2.4 1 February to 31 March → 50%
 - 3.2.5 1 April onwards → 40%
- 3.3 These are fixed bands, not pro-rata, and are designed to ensure that mid-year enrolment remains commercially aligned with full-year enrolment.
- 3.4 Mid-year tuition is non-refundable.
- 3.5 Capital Development Levy:
 - 3.5.1 Up to 31 March → 100%
 - 3.5.2 From 1 April onwards → 50%
- 3.6 All other fees remain payable in full at enrolment.
- 3.7 Payment of mid-year tuition shall follow the School's standard payment structure, applied only to the remaining instalment dates within the academic year. The School reserves the right to require an adjusted payment schedule.
- 3.8 All mid-year enrolments are subject to approval by the School's Leadership Team.

4. Refundable Deposit Terms

- 4.1 The deposit is held as security against any outstanding fees, damages, losses, or unpaid charges across all children within the family.
- 4.2 The deposit does not accrue interest.
- 4.3 The deposit may not be used to offset tuition fees or other charges during enrolment.
- 4.4 The deposit will be applied toward any outstanding balances prior to any further recovery action.
- 4.5 The deposit will be refunded only upon full withdrawal of all children, subject to:
 - 4.5.1 Full settlement of all outstanding balances
 - 4.5.2 Return of all school property, including books, materials, and ID cards
 - 4.5.3 Clearance of any damages, losses, or additional charges
- 4.6 Where notice is not properly given or fees remain unpaid, the deposit will be applied toward outstanding balances and may be forfeited in whole or in part.
- 4.7 The deposit is non-transferable and will only be refunded after final clearance.
- 4.8 School Leaving Certificates, reports, transcripts, transfer documents, and references will only be issued after full financial and administrative clearance.

Fees Policy

5. Annual Commitment & Re-Enrolment

- 5.1 Enrolment constitutes a commitment to the academic year or the remaining portion of it.
- 5.2 Re-enrolment is automatic for the following academic year unless written notice of withdrawal is submitted by 31 March.
- 5.3 Failure to provide notice by 31 March will result in automatic re-enrolment billing.
- 5.4 The re-enrolment fee will be invoiced and must be paid by 30 April to secure the student's place.
- 5.5 The re-enrolment fee is not an additional fee and will be credited toward the first instalment of tuition for the upcoming academic year.
- 5.6 Failure to pay the re-enrolment fee by 30 April may result in the place being released.

6. Payment Plans, Methods & Currency

- 6.1 The School will issue a single annual invoice at the start of the academic year, typically at least four (4) weeks prior to the first instalment due date. This invoice will outline the full annual tuition and the selected payment plan, including all instalment due dates. For students enrolling mid-year, an invoice will be issued covering the applicable fees for the remaining portion of the academic year.
- 6.2 Fees are structured on an annual basis, representing the full academic year. Where a student enrolls mid-year, fees are calculated in accordance with the fixed entry structure set out in Section 7.
- 6.3 Instalment plans are structured as alternative payment options with increased flexibility and a higher total fee compared to the annual payment option.
- 6.4 Instalment options and due dates are as follows:
 - 6.4.1 Plan A → 1 August
 - 6.4.2 Plan B → 1 August, 1 November, 1 February
 - 6.4.3 Plan C → 1 August, 1 October, 1 January, 1 March
- 6.5 Any applicable discounts apply only to selected payment plans as outlined in the Fees Guide.
- 6.6 Instalment plans are subject to approval and may be withdrawn where payment history is not satisfactory.
- 6.7 Accepted payment methods include bank transfer, card, cash, mobile money, and cheque.
- 6.8 Fees are quoted and payable in Tanzanian Shillings, TZS.
- 6.9 Approved NGOs, embassies, and organisations may pay in USD, at the exchange rate determined by the School.
- 6.10 All bank charges, transfer fees, intermediary bank deductions, currency conversion costs, and any other transaction-related costs are the responsibility of the payer. The School must receive the full invoiced amount in cleared funds, net of all charges. Any shortfall arising from deductions will be treated as an outstanding balance and must be settled immediately.
- 6.11 Payment is recognised only once funds have been received in full and cleared in the School's designated account.
- 6.12 Parents are required to submit proof of payment. Payments may not be allocated until proof has been received and verified. Any delay in allocation arising from failure to provide proof of payment remains the responsibility of the bill payer.

7. Mid-Year Enrolment

- 7.1 The following are charged separately and are not included in tuition:
 - 7.1.1 Learning materials and books
 - 7.1.2 Uniforms
 - 7.1.3 Stationery
 - 7.1.4 Transport
 - 7.1.5 External examination fees
 - 7.1.6 Field trips and excursions
 - 7.1.7 Competitions, galas, events, and extracurricular activities
 - 7.1.8 Replacement items, including lost books and ID cards
- 7.2 All additional charges must be paid in advance or by the communicated deadline.

Fees Policy

8. Fee Deadlines, Non-Payment & Enforcement

- 8.1 Fees are due strictly by the stated due dates.
- 8.2 Payments received after the due date are considered overdue.
- 8.3 A short administrative window of up to 5 days beyond the due date may be permitted at the School's discretion. This does not extend the due date and should not be relied upon.
- 8.4 The School reserves the right to deny, suspend, or restrict attendance where fees are not paid in advance in line with the agreed payment schedule.
- 8.5 Late payment charges of TZS 75,000 per week per child apply until settlement in full.
- 8.6 Dishonoured cheques incur a charge of TZS 100,000.
- 8.7 Fees unpaid beyond the permitted period may result in:
 - 8.7.1 Suspension or restriction of attendance
 - 8.7.2 Application of the deposit toward outstanding balances
 - 8.7.3 Administrative and academic restrictions
 - 8.7.4 Cancellation of any agreed instalment arrangement
- 8.8 Continued non-payment may result in cancellation of registration.
- 8.9 Failure to adhere to an agreed payment plan will result in cancellation of that plan and all outstanding balances becoming immediately payable in full.
- 8.10 The School will prioritise internal recovery measures. Legal recovery may be pursued at the School's discretion as a final measure.

9. Outstanding Balances & Restrictions

- 9.1 Students with unpaid balances may be subject to:
 - 9.1.1 Denial of access to school premises and classrooms
 - 9.1.2 Restriction from extracurricular activities
 - 9.1.3 Withholding of reports, transcripts, certificates, references, and enrolment letters
 - 9.1.4 Ineligibility for internal or external assessments or examinations
 - 9.1.5 Exclusion from events, field trips, competitions, galas, and activities
 - 9.1.6 Suspension of communication platforms, including parent portals, WhatsApp groups, and newsletters
 - 9.1.7 Ineligibility for re-enrolment
 - 9.1.8 Restriction on future enrolment of the student or associated family members

10. Absences & Seat Holding

- 10.1 Fees remain payable in full and are not subject to refund, reduction, credit, or concession during any period of student absence or disruption to normal school operations, including illness, travel, holidays, public holidays, temporary relocation, medical circumstances, or any other voluntary or involuntary absence.
- 10.2 Fees also remain payable where the School is required to close, restrict access, or modify its operations due to circumstances beyond its reasonable control, including government directives, public health events, civil unrest, security concerns, adverse conditions, or any other unforeseen circumstances.
- 10.3 Where reasonably possible, the School may implement alternative methods of educational delivery, which shall not affect the obligation to pay fees in full.
- 10.4 The School may utilise designated make-up days within the academic calendar, at its discretion, where additional instructional time is required to support curriculum delivery.
- 10.5 The use or non-use of such days, and any adjustments to the academic calendar, shall not entitle parents to any refund, reduction, credit, or concession.
- 10.6 No refunds, credits, or deferrals will be granted under any such circumstances.
- 10.7 Seats are held only where fees are paid in accordance with the agreed payment schedule.
- 10.8 Non-payment may result in de-registration.
- 10.9 Seats are non-transferable and remain subject to availability.
- 10.10 Where a student is absent for twenty-one (21) or more school days, whether consecutive or cumulative, the School reserves the right to require the student to repeat the academic year, at its sole discretion, based on academic, developmental, and attendance considerations.

11. Withdrawal, Notice & Refunds

11.1 Written notice of withdrawal is required.

11.2 Where full annual tuition has been paid:

11.2.1 Written notice of at least four (4) weeks prior to the start of the academic year → 90% tuition refund

11.2.2 Withdrawal on or before 1 October → 60% tuition refund

11.2.3 Withdrawal on or before 1 December → 30% tuition refund

11.2.4 Withdrawal after 1 December → no tuition refund

11.3 For families on instalment plans:

11.3.1 A minimum of six (6) weeks' written notice prior to the next instalment due date is required to avoid liability for that instalment

11.3.2 Instalments paid or due are non-refundable

11.3.3 Liability for future instalments ceases only where proper written notice is provided in accordance with this policy

11.3.4 Attendance at any point during an instalment period constitutes full acceptance and liability for that instalment

11.4 Where required notice is not provided:

11.4.1 The next instalment becomes immediately due and payable in full

11.4.2 The deposit will be applied toward any outstanding balance

11.4.3 Any remaining balance remains payable and may be subject to further recovery action

11.5 The following fees are non-refundable:

11.5.1 Registration fee

11.5.2 Re-enrolment fee

11.5.3 Capital Development Levy

11.5.4 Learning materials and books

11.5.5 All other non-tuition charges unless expressly stated otherwise

11.6 Withdrawal or expulsion due to disciplinary reasons will result in forfeiture of all fees paid.

12. General Provisions
