CASE STUDY

Peru

From engineering to the High Andes

The People

Friends and colleagues from a US engineering company wanted an adventure that would put their practical skills to use, contribute to something meaningful and challenge them together.

The Access

Through our partnership with the Andean Alliance, they spent five days living and working alongside farming communities in a remote corner of the High Andes.

Surrounded by vast mountain landscapes, they helped develop an irrigation system and reforest an area above the community's strawberry farms, experiencing Andean life from the inside while contributing to work led by local people.

The Experience

The group then swapped tools for trekking boots, setting off on a bespoke four-day route through remote valleys and over high mountain passes to Machu Picchu.

Professional skills, purposeful contribution and an unforgettable shared achievement—all in one extraordinary Leap.



CASE STUDY

Kenya

A family adventure with purpose

The People

This family wanted more than a beach holiday and safari. They wanted to experience Kenya together, contribute to something meaningful and still enjoy the comfort of a fabulous family holiday.

The Access

Staying in beautiful beachside accommodation on Kenya's Indian Ocean coastline gave them the best of both worlds: relaxed family time in an extraordinary setting, combined with five purposeful days alongside the conservation team at Oceans Alive.

During the day, they helped build fuel-efficient stoves for local families, took part in coral restoration and learnt directly from the people protecting the coastline, before returning to the beach to swim, relax and enjoy time together.

The Experience

They then swapped coral reefs and coastal communities for the vast landscapes and extraordinary wildlife of a Kenyan safari.

A family holiday with so much more woven in – beautiful surroundings, meaningful contribution, safari adventure and stories they will share for years to come.

Peru

A school reunion with a difference

The People

A group of friends wanted to celebrate a 60th birthday with something far more memorable than an ordinary holiday, time together, a meaningful connection with Sri Lanka and enough adventure to feel like a genuine achievement.

The Access

Through our partnership with the Andean Alliance, they spent time alongside local teams in the High Andes, contributing to ongoing projects and gaining a rare insight into life in this remote part of Peru.

Rather than simply passing through, they met the people behind the work and experienced a side of the country most visitors never see.

The Experience

The group then swapped project work for adventure, taking on the challenge of reaching Machu Picchu and exploring the remarkable landscapes, communities and historic sites of the Sacred Valley.

A school reunion reimagined – shared purpose, new challenges and fourteen old friends with a whole new collection of stories to tell.



CASE STUDY

Sri Lanka

A 60th birthday with purpose

The People

A group of friends wanted to celebrate a 60th birthday with something far more memorable than an ordinary holiday, time together, a meaningful connection with Sri Lanka and enough adventure to feel like a genuine achievement.

The Access

Staying at beautiful Tekanda Lodge in southern Sri Lanka gave them time to relax and celebrate, while Tekanda's long-standing local relationships opened the door to experiences few visitors could arrange.

They spent time with a women's empowerment initiative and a community cricket club - meeting the people behind both, hearing their stories and supporting work rooted in local life.

The Experience

The group then swapped the tropical south for Sri Lanka's spectacular Central Highlands, where dramatic landscapes and shared challenges revealed a completely different side of the country.

A 60th birthday reimagined - beautiful surroundings, genuine local connection, adventure and an unforgettable celebration of friendship.



CASE STUDY

Cambodia

A Book Club steps inside the story

The People

A group of friends brought together by their book club wanted to take their shared love of stories somewhere new - combining time together with meaningful contribution and the chance to discover Cambodia.

The Access

In Siem Reap, they spent time supporting our reading club and working alongside Water for Cambodia, learning how access to books, education and clean water can transform everyday life. Through our long-standing local relationships, they met the people behind both projects and experienced a side of Cambodia that visitors rarely have the opportunity to see.

The Experience

The group then swapped project life for exploring the history and energy of Phnom Penh and the riverside town of Kampot.
