ISSUES

SEVERELY DAMAGED ANTERIOR PRIMARY TEETH RECONSTRUCTION IS A CHALLENGE WHEN SPECIAL NEEDS PEDIATRIC PATIENTS ARE CONCERNED. THE PRESENT REPORT DESCRIBES A LOW-COST TECHNIQUE NAMED "BABY FORM" WHICH CONSISTED OF FABRICATION OF CROWN MOLD TO FACILITATE TOOTH RECONSTRUCTION.

MATERIALS



PROCEDURES

1) TOOTH SELECTION:



2) PREHEAT TREATMENT OF A SOFT PLASTIC PLATE UNTIL A MALLEABLE STATE.



3) PLACEMENT OF THE PLATE OVER THE ACRYLIC TOOTH MODEL.

4) SETTING OF THE PLATE OVER THE TOOTH MODEL BY PUSHING THEM AGAINST A LITTLE POT OF DOUGH.

5) TRIMMING AND FINISHING OF THE CROWN MOLD.



TOOTH RECONSTRUCTION:

1) CAVITY REMOVAL.
2) ETCHING.

3) APPLICATION OF BONDING AGENT.

4) ADAPTATION OF THE CROWN MOLD TO THE CERVICAL MARGIN OF THE TOOTH.

5) COMPOSITE FILING (OFUS BULK FILL FGM® A1 COLOR) AND LIGHT CURING.
