

Farm Cornwall is the only Cornwall-based charity dedicated solely to supporting farmers, farm workers, farming families and rural communities across the county.

For 25 years we have built a trusted reputation for providing practical, confidential support to people involved in agriculture who are facing complex personal, financial and business challenges.

Our team works directly with individuals and families across Cornwall, offering one-to-one advice, outreach visits, workshops and training. We help farmers navigate change, access funding opportunities, strengthen their businesses, support well-being and maintain high standards of animal welfare.

Supporting Farming Communities

Over 600 farming families have received support from Farm Cornwall, and as pressures on the agricultural sector increase, demand for our services continues to grow.

Supporting farmers strengthens Cornwall's rural economy, protects animal welfare standards and helps sustain the communities that shape our county's landscape and heritage.

A key part of our work is building supportive farming communities. Farming can be isolating, and many people experience loneliness in rural areas.

Through networks such as **Ladies in Wellies (500+ members)** and **Next Generation (300+ members)** we bring people together to share experiences, build confidence and support one another.

Why We Need Support

Demand for Farm Cornwall's support continues to grow as pressures on the agricultural sector increase. Farmers and rural families are facing significant financial, business and personal challenges, and the support they need is becoming more complex and long-term.

Each case we support costs the charity approximately £1,000, reflecting the depth of practical, confidential and tailored support required.

Prevention & Future Support

While Farm Cornwall provides vital support during times of crisis, our work also focuses on prevention. We deliver training, skills workshops and community initiatives that help farmers build resilience, develop knowledge and access support early.

At the same time, grant funding is becoming increasingly competitive. To ensure the long-term sustainability of Farm Cornwall and to continue supporting Cornwall's farming community, we are developing partnerships with organisations and individuals that share our commitment to rural communities and the future of farming.

Support cases are becoming more complex and long-term

Our Work in Numbers (2024–2025)

The scale and reach of Farm Cornwall’s work across the county over the course of a year:

113 farms supported

Providing practical, confidential support to farmers and rural families across Cornwall.

279 farm visits

Delivering face-to-face advice and support where it is needed most.

35,000 miles travelled


Reaching farming communities across Cornwall’s rural and often isolated areas.

47% of farms supported were tenanted and **53%** owned.

Additional insight:s:

- Mental health concerns appeared more frequently in owner-occupied farms
- Debt issues were more common among tenanted farms
