1	Review Current Landscape	Analyze policies, MLL data, and classroom experiences.	Tools: EL Data Inventory, Student Interviews, Teacher Focus Groups.
2	Strengthen Adoption Criteria	Integrate MLL-specific review criteria into frameworks.	Tools: MLL Review Criteria, Scenarios for MLL Criteria.
3	Form & Prepare Your Committee	Assemble an inclusive team and provide responsive training.	Tools: Committee Checklist, Training Agenda.
4	Conduct the Materials Review	Evaluate materials using inclusive criteria, pilot them, and engage publishers.	Tools: Review Checklist, Pilot Checklist, Publisher Checklist, Role of School Board.
5	Launch & Implement	Develop a launch plan ensuring adopted materials meet MLL needs.	Tools: Implementation Checklist
