Prayer That Reached Heaven

June 2025

God's people should pray to Him in every situation, and as they adjust their hearts to Him in obedience, repentance and worship.

When Hezekiah became King in Jerusalem he restored true worship to the LORD. Idolatry had been so prevalent under his father, King Ahaz, that he had *"shut the doors of the LORD's temple and set up altars at every street corner in Jerusalem."* (2 Chronicles 28:24b) Hezekiah followed the example of his forefather, David, and did what was right in the eyes of the Lord. In his first month as King, *"he opened the doors of the temple of the LORD and repaired them."* (29:3b) He charged the Priests and the Levites to consecrate themselves and the temple of the LORD which took 16 days to complete. He gathered the city officials and involved them along with the priests and Levites in sacrifices and musical worship as they were being dedicated to the LORD, *"So they sang praises with gladness and bowed their heads and worshiped."* (29:30b)

Hezekiah called all of Israel and Judah to celebrate the Passover even though it was not the regular time to celebrate the Passover. All had not been prepared or consecrated to celebrate at the appropriate time. It would take time for all the details of *"what was written"* (30:18b) to be fulfilled, but Hezekiah prayed that God would accept the worship from their hearts. *"But Hezekiah prayed for them, saying, 'May the Lord, who is good, pardon everyone who sets his heart on seeking God – the LORD, the God of his fathers – even if he is not clean according to the rules of the sanctuary. And the LORD heard Hezekiah and healed the people."* (30:18b-10)

Charles Spurgeon said, *"Prayer is never out of season.... Prayer gains audience with Heaven.... In every condition... God will welcome your prayer and answer it from His holy place. Nor is praying ever futile. True prayer is evermore true power."* (Spurgeon on Prayer – How to Converse with God)

If your heart has shifted away from God or grown stagnant or calloused, you can pray. Sometimes people's lives become entangled with the world or sinful patterns, and they find it difficult to unscramble their circumstances or to shift back to God. Remember that prayer is never out of season and that prayer gains audience with God in heaven. God will hear the prayer from your heart. In Hezekiah's day, *"The priests and the Levites stood to bless the people, and God heard them, for their prayer reached heaven, his holy dwelling place."* (2 Chronicles 30:27) As believers in Christ, *"Let us then approach the throne of grace with confidence, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help us in our time of need."* (Hebrews 4:16) Begin with prayer and trust the LORD to hear and answer.
