

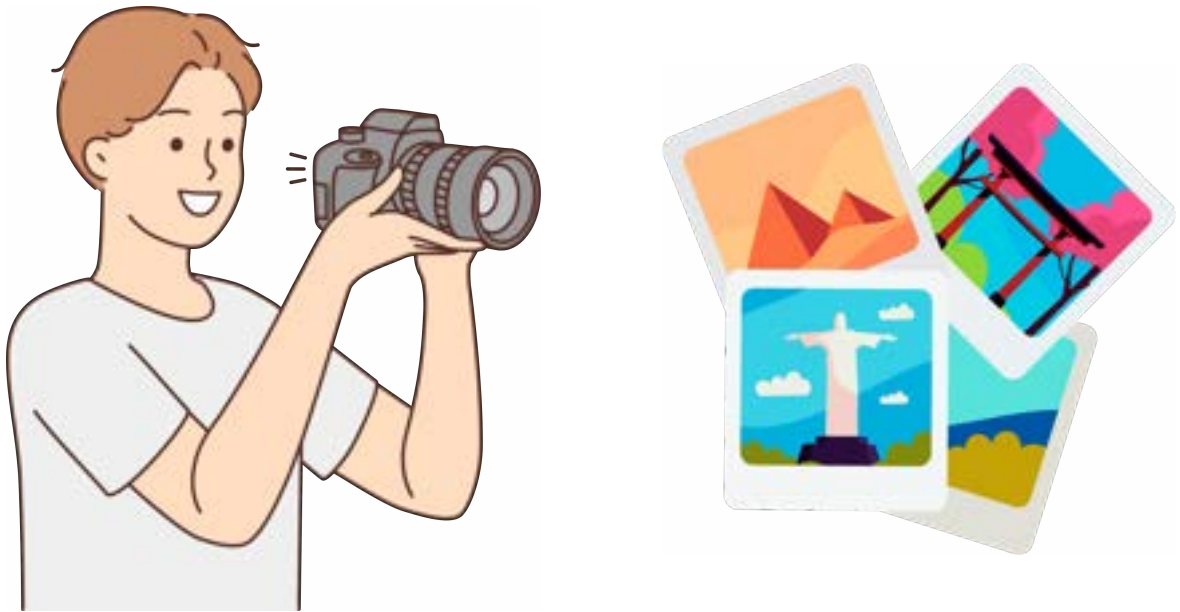


How To Take Good Photos Of Your Art



Why are photos important?

It is important to take a clear, high-quality photo of your artwork.



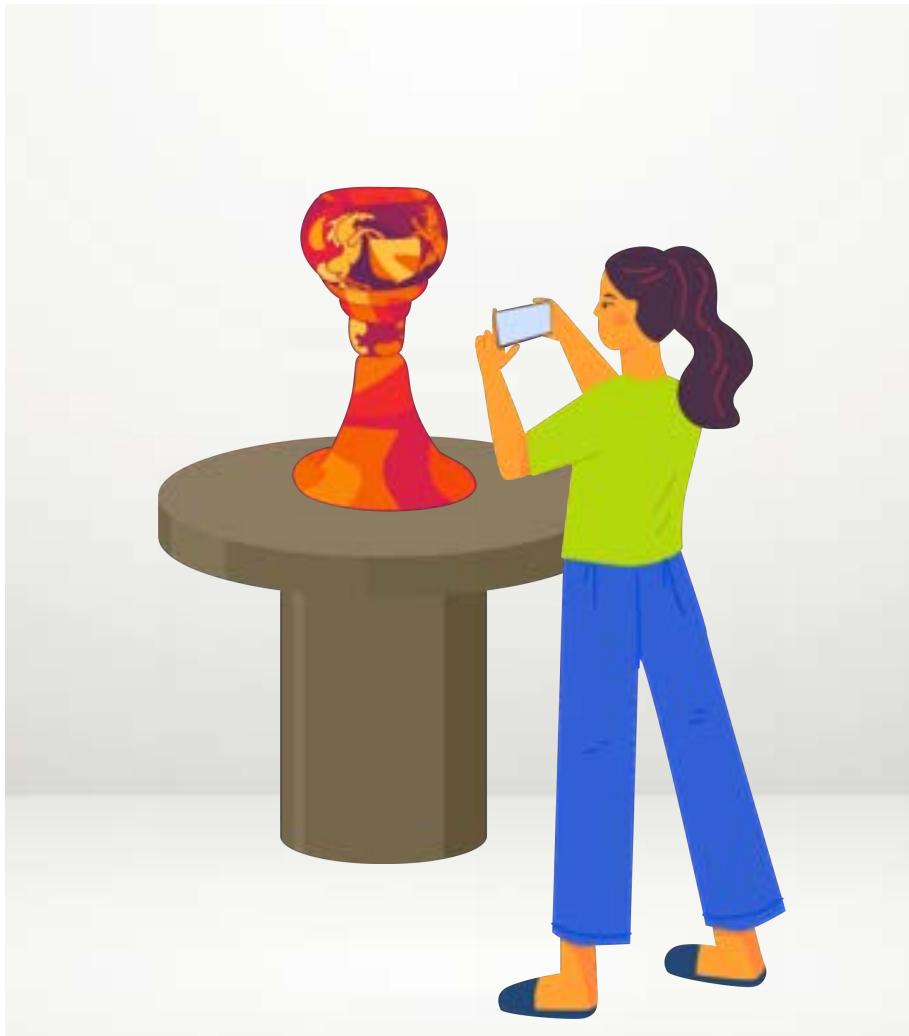
Good photos will help the judges choose which artwork to show in the exhibition.



Here are some helpful tips:

1. Choose a simple background

Take your photo in front of a plain white or black wall or sheet.



This helps your artwork stand out and look neat.

2. Hang flat artwork on a wall

If your artwork is flat (like a drawing or painting), hang it on the wall to photograph.



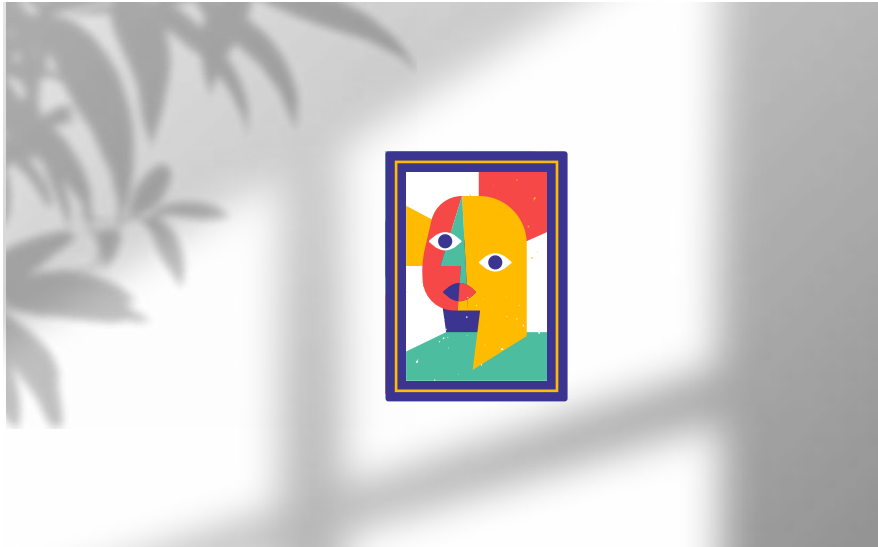
Make sure it is straight and not slanted.



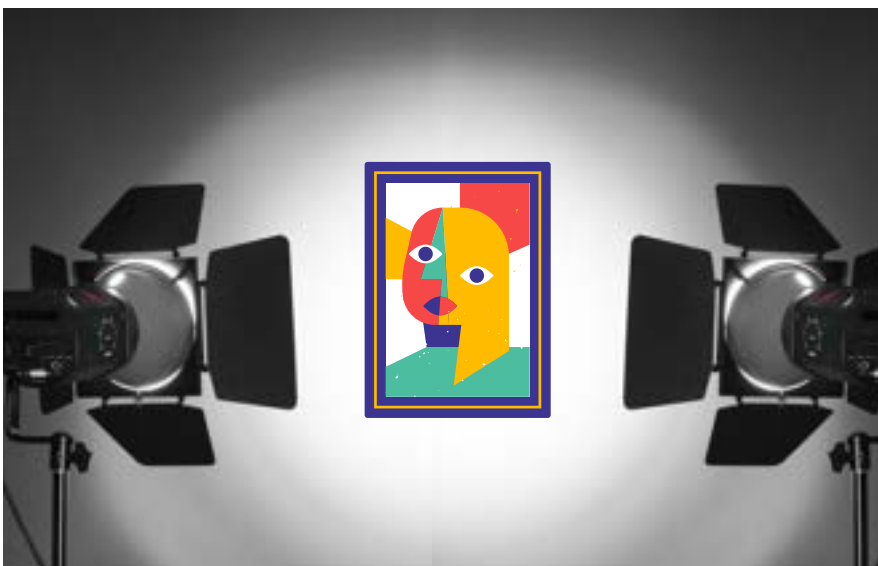
3. Make sure it is well lit

Your artwork needs good lighting to look its best.

Try to use natural light



Or use two lamps - one on each side

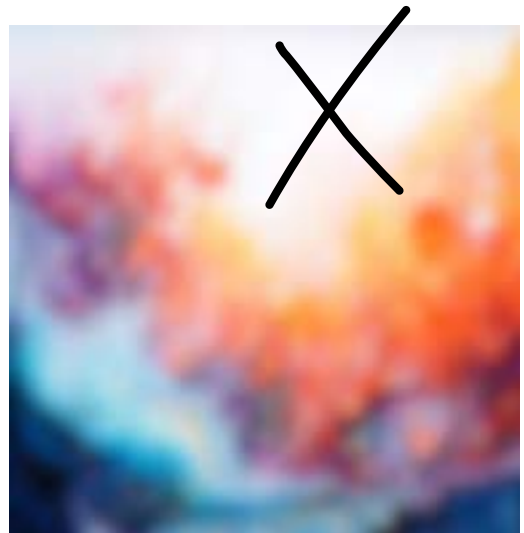
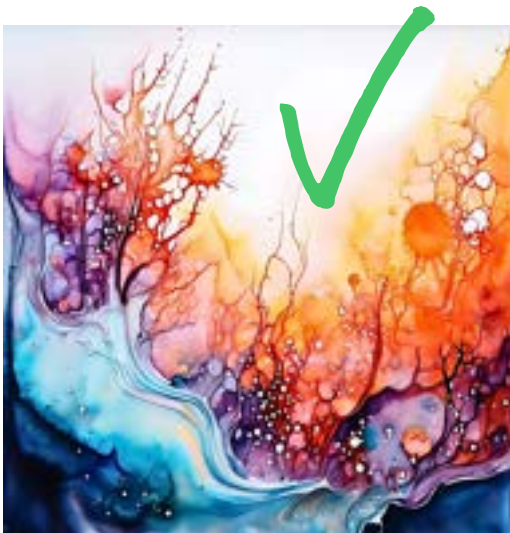


4. Keep your camera still

Use a tripod or put your camera on something steady

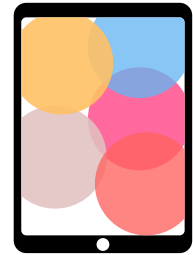


This helps the photo look sharp and not blurry.



5. Use the best camera you can

You don't need a professional camera.
Use the best camera or phone you can find.
