Despite any hardship we may face, we are still hopeful that we can make an impact this year and we are excited to share some of our goals for this year with you.

In our last Newsletter, we shared our end of year Recap; if you didn't see it, you can go to our site <u>here</u> to view it. This year we are focusing on 3 core areas: **Growth**, **Organization**, and **Impact**.

Growth

Last year, we hosted all of our in-person events in New York, gained *over* **100** members, and hosted a few virtual events with Arab leaders across multiple tech companies. This year, we plan to expand into several major US cities (TBA), cross the 1k member threshold, have more frequent dialogue with Arab leaders, and encourage our members to support each other through our Discord to organically scale our impact.

Organization

Last year, we brought on **3** volunteers, built several integrations to scale the services we offer, formed relationships with several other Arab organizations, and were invited to multiple Conferences. This year, we want to bring on more volunteers to grow the number of services we can offer, form more organizational and institutional relationships/collaborations, attend more conferences, and create a framework for other Arab organizations to use in order to bootstrap themselves to fit the growing needs of our community.

Impact

Last year, we provided *over* **100** unique services to our members, and through our community, we were able to help a member get a job at a top tech company! We also connected Arab ERG (Employee Resource Group) leads across **10+** companies. **This year, we have already helped place another member at a top tech company, and helped several reach late stage interview rounds!** For the remainder of the year, our primary focus will be on how we can continue to improve these services (both scale and quality), upskill our members, provide more programs to the community, connect more Arab leaders, and showcase the impact of Arab innovation.

We have much more planned this year and are excited to announce more detailed plans when the time comes. Thank you all for being a part of the Collective!
