

Instructions: Upgrade from Windows 10 to Windows 11

On October 14, 2025, Microsoft's support for Windows 10 will expire. Therefore, we recommend updating to Windows 11.

1. Check system requirements

1. Connect the simulator to the internet
2. Press **Windows Key + I** to open **Settings**.
3. Go to **Update and Security** → **Windows Update**. If necessary, still run any open updates for Windows 10.
4. Check if the message appears:
"This PC can run Windows 11". **You can now conveniently upgrade to Windows 11 and continue in the instructions at point 4.**

If you don't see the update or communicate that your PC doesn't meet the minimum requirements, download Microsoft's **PC Health Check Tool**:

2. Enable TPM and Secure Boot (if necessary)

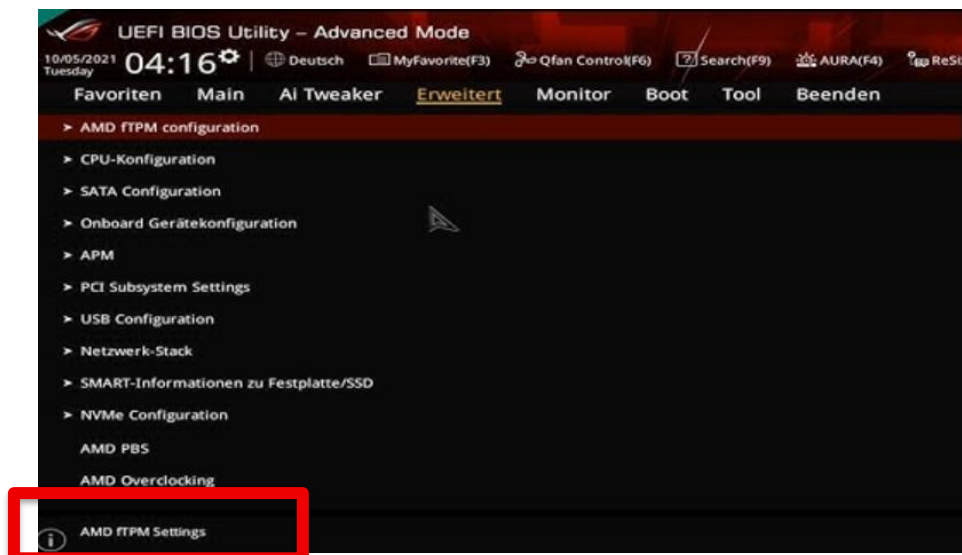
If the check shows that **TPM** or **Secure Boot** are disabled, you must enable them in the BIOS.

To get into the ASUS BIOS (UEFI Utility):

1. Restart the PC.
2. Press the **FN (or Delete)** and **F2 keys (depending on the model)** several times during startup.
3. The **ASUS UEFI BIOS Utility** opens

Enable TPM:

1. Switch to the **Advanced menu**.
2. Go to **PCH-FW Configuration** or **AMD fTPM Configuration** (name depends on processor).



3. Set **TPM Device Selection** to **Firmware TPM** (or **PTT** for Intel, **fTPM** for AMD).
4. Save changes with **F10** and restart PC.

Activate Secure Boot:

1. In the BIOS, switch to the **Boot** menu .
2. **Find Secure Boot** and set it to **Enabled**.
3. Save again with **F10** and restart.

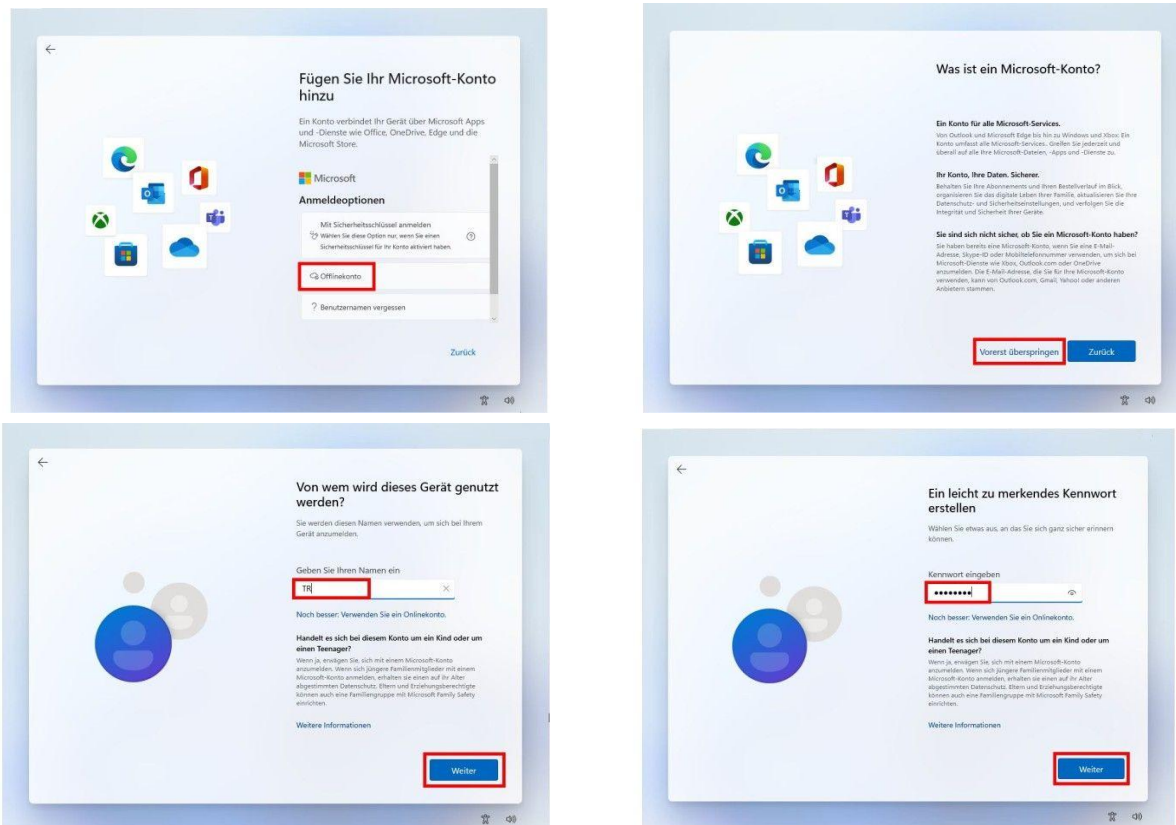
3. Start Windows 11 Update

If TPM and Secure Boot are active:

1. Open Settings with **Windows Key + I**.
2. Go to **Update and Security** → **Windows Update**.
3. If Windows 11 is offered: **Click Download and install now** .
4. If it's not offered:

4. Complete installation

- The PC restarts several times.
- All programs and files are retained.
- Skip registering your Microsoft account or create an "offline account."



- After installation, check the Windows updates to get the latest drivers. **Important:** Download [and install](#) the Steam update.

5. Tip for our simulator customers

If the update fails:

- Check if the latest ASUS BIOS version is installed.
- If in doubt, first perform a BIOS update from the ASUS site.
- **We are happy to support you via remote maintenance, but you should have made the settings in the BIOS (point 2), as this is not possible via remote maintenance.**
