

PRODUCTION TECHNICIAN

The Production Technician is responsible for preparing and executing CCC Next Gen services and special events, while supporting the broader production needs of the church. This role includes leading volunteer production teams through recruitment, training, scheduling, and ongoing care. The Production Technician also oversees the maintenance of all Next Gen AVL systems and provides AVL support to ministries in classrooms and other meeting spaces during peak hours.

PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITIES

- Lead the Next Gen volunteer production teams to execute services/events- 25%
- Recruit, train, schedule and disciple volunteer teams – 20%
- Setup venues for rehearsals and services including assisting in the worship center – 15%
- Support additional events, ministries, and worship venues around CCC – 15%
- Maintain, repair, and service AVL equipment and systems as needed – 15%
- Collaborative meetings – 10%

SKILLS & BACKGROUND

- Able to recruit, lead, and disciple volunteers at a high level
- Experience working with audio / lighting / video systems
- Basic proficiency in audio and video editing
- Able to diagnose and repair production gear at the component level

TYPE OF POSITION

- Full-time hourly role averaging 40-45 hours per week.
- Typical schedule is noted below but can vary slightly depending upon key events:
 - Sunday 7 AM – 12:30 PM // 3 – 8 PM
 - Monday 9 AM – 5 PM
 - Tuesday 8:30 AM – 5 PM
 - Wednesday 9 AM – 5 PM
 - Thursday 1:30 PM – 9:30 PM
- Staff Supervised: None
- Volunteers Supervised: Volunteer production teams
- Benefits include paid time off, health insurance, retirement
- The duties of this position are primarily conducted in an indoor office environment with typical lighting, heating and cooling.

PHYSICAL DEMANDS

In order to successfully perform the duties of the position, the individual needs to be able to do the physical requirements noted below. (C = Constant (>50%); F = Frequent (25%-50%); O = Occasional (1-25%); N = Never (0%))

- F - Light Lifting (<20 lbs)
- O - Moderate Lifting (20-50 lbs)
- O - Heavy Lifting (>50 lbs)
- O - Standing
- F - Reaching (extending hands and arms in any direction)
- F - Sitting (for sustained periods of time)
- F - Walking (moving foot to accomplish tasks)
- O - Repetitive motion (sustained movements of wrists/hands/fingers)
- O - Bending
- O - Pushing/pulling
- O - Driving
