The week that followed was vibrant and purposeful, with pupils quickly re-engaging in learning and a wide range of academic, creative, and enrichment activities taking place across all phases.


As we move into Term 2, we look forward to building on this positive start, continuing to support high standards, pupil well-being, and strong partnerships with our school community.
