Treviso, Italy • N.V.

85% Glera, 15% Chardonnay • 11% ABV • 750 mL / 187 mL

Bright and lively, with pear and green apple, finishing on soft, steady bubbles.

Pairs with: aperitivo bites, brunch, light seafood, or on its own.

PROSECCO ROSÉ DOC

Treviso, Italy • Millesimato 2024 Brut

85% Glera, 15% Pinot Noir • 11% ABV • 750 mL

Soft rose-gold hue, delicate florals and red fruit, with fine, steady bubbles.

Pairs with: prosciutto-wrapped melon, burrata, strawberry shortcake.



ROSÉ

Abruzzo, Italy • 2024

100% Montepulciano • 12.5% ABV • 750 mL

A bright pink pour with strawberry and delicate florals, closing on a subtle citrus finish.

Pairs with: grilled seafood, charcuterie, fresh salads, or a summer aperitif.

Sicily, Italy • 2024

Nero d'Avola, Syrah & Merlot • 13.5% ABV • 750 mL

Ruby red with an intense berry bouquet — medium-bodied, with a smooth, harmonious finish.
