Since its establishment, our organisation has strived to contribute to strengthening the confidence of its clients and the market by providing certification and verification services in compliance with the applicable legislation, standards and accreditation requirements.

In addition to our product certification activities, we also operate as a management system certification and verification body. In the course of our activities, we attach particular importance to the continuous improvement of professional competence, the preservation of independence and impartiality, and the provision of high-quality services.

Our Values include striving for balanced cooperation with our partners, developing our governance systems and processes, regularly training our employees, and ensuring the efficient operation of our organisation.

The company's management uses its governance systems based on the MSZ EN ISO/IEC 17065, MSZ EN ISO/IEC 17021 and MSZ EN ISO/IEC 17029 standards as a management tool, thereby ensuring transparency in professional and business operations and continuous improvement.

Our organisation works with professionals who are familiar with several standards and have gained experience in the operation of both for-profit and non-profit organisations. They are required to participate in regular continuing education to ensure that they have the necessary professional competencies for certification processes.

We work in a planned manner, organising training courses, consultations and professional meetings every year.

We place particular emphasis on new and innovative ideas and strive to ensure their smooth assessment. We also consider it important to provide our colleagues with a good working atmosphere and a safe working environment, and to strengthen their sense of belonging through internal events and team-building programmes.
