

Information for Supervising Adults



Students are the responsibility of the school and accompanying supervisors during the day of your visit outside of lesson times. During lessons, there is no need for adults to attend unless they wish to participate in the lesson. An adult must be present at the designated meeting area to collect students at the end of each lesson.

Packed lunches must be consumed in the designated areas. We also ask that all groups follow the 'pack in and pack out' principle—please assist your group in taking all rubbish off the mountain.

Your group leader will liaise with mountain staff to organise passes, rentals, and lessons. If you have any concerns, please speak directly with your group leader.

Any concerns or queries regarding instructors should be discussed with your group leader, who will communicate with our Snow School Supervisor.



All adult supervisors are expected to assist students with equipment collection. Adults who are renting equipment should wait until all students have finished their rental process before collecting their own gear.

Bags are not to be left in the seating areas of the cafeteria. Your group will be advised of the designated area for bag storage upon arrival.

A 'student gear guide' is provided to the school in the parent information document. We recommend all adults on the trip read this guide and prepare accordingly.

In the event of an accident or emergency, please contact your group leader directly. Do not contact off-site parents regarding these matters.
