Mr. Ortega joined Vitarich in 1994 as an Extension Veterinarian, and, since then has handled various positions as Veterinary Services Group Head, Contract Growing Operations Head, Technical Head, and Poultry and Livestock Division Head, until his appointment as Senior Vice President for Poultry and Food General Manager. As Vitarich's Chief Operating Officer, Mr. Ortega shall, among others, further drive Vitarich's operational strategies forward to ensure Vitarich's agility and responsiveness in a competitive marketplace. He is a Doctor of Veterinary Science and Medicine, having obtained his degree at the Central Luzon State University in 1992. He also earned his degree in Bachelor of Science in Animal Husbandry in the same University in 1990. On the other hand, Mr. Tan joined Vitarich on 11 January 2022 and has since served as Vitarich's Vice President and Finance Operations Director, where he managed Vitarich's financial processes and risks. With his appointment as Senior Vice President and Chief Finance Officer, Mr. Tan will lead Vitarich's financial strategy and management and help shape a robust financial framework that supports Vitarich's growth and operational excellence. Prior to joining Vitarich, Mr. Tan has more or less 20 years of career experience mostly in the banking and financial services industry as well as technology software and services.
