## Liev Schreiber

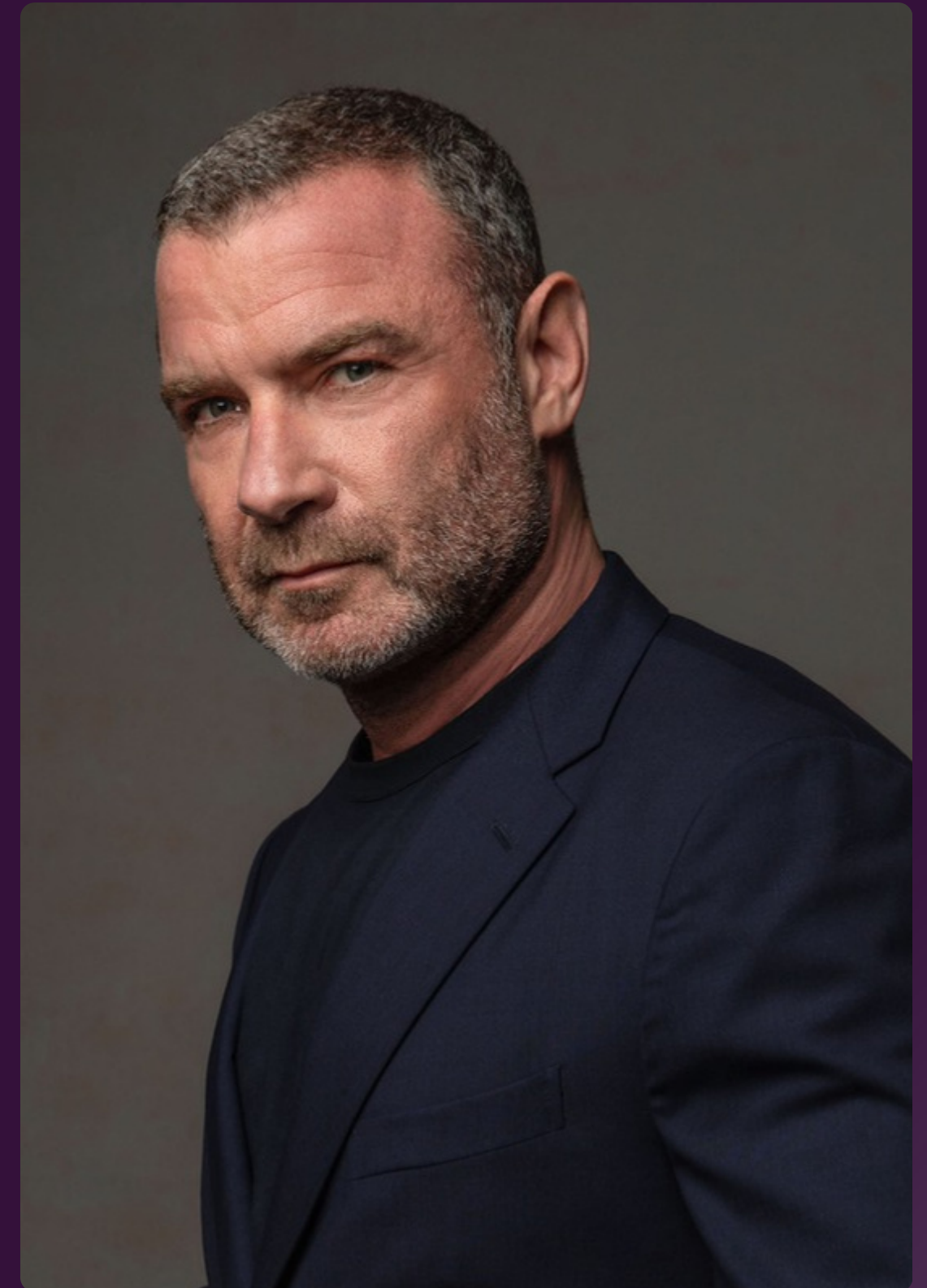

### Humanitarian Solidarity Award

Heralded as "the finest American theater actor of his generation" by the New York Times, Liev Schreiber has built a repertoire of resonant, humanistic, and often gritty performances across film, theater, and television.

Of Ukrainian heritage, Schreiber has long supported cross-cultural ties through his work, beginning with his directorial debut *Everything is Illuminated*, which follows a young American Jewish man to western Ukraine to find the woman who saved his grandfather during the Holocaust. Following Russia's 2022 invasion, he co-founded BlueCheck Ukraine to connect Ukrainians with urgent financial support and became an ambassador for President Volodymyr Zelensky's United24 initiative. In 2024, he co-directed the feature documentary *Meeting Zelenskyy*, chronicling the president's transformation from entertainer to wartime leader.

Schreiber's humanitarian efforts have earned widespread recognition, including Governor George Pataki's Freedom Award and the Dick Cavett Artistic Champion Award from the Hamptons International Film Festival, both in 2024. In 2023, he was honored by Creative Community for Peace as an Ambassador of Peace for his advocacy for the Jewish community and received the Ellis Island Medal of Honor for his contributions to American society.

Praise Nyokabi is a dedicated gender advocate and youth leader committed to advancing the rights and dignity of women and marginalized communities. She holds a degree in Gender Studies and has further strengthened her leadership through certifications in global leadership programs, including engagement with the United Nations, and is currently as an online fellow with the WILD Fellowship (Washington, DC).

Praise Nyokabi has been volunteering in Programs and policy department in CTWOO. She has been sitting in the advocacy committee where she contributed so highly on plight of children of Widowed Person's. She ensured their interests were captured before the Widowed Persons Bill, 2026 was submitted into Parliament for next steps. Her work extends into grassroots community engagement, where she actively supports widows through field activities—organizing support groups, mentoring teenagers, and guiding orphans during school holidays. She is deeply driven by the belief that destinies are shaped through access to quality education, as emphasized in SDG 4 Access to good and quality education.

Her passion for advocacy began during her university years, where she founded Safe Generation, a support group for young people affected by domestic abuse and trauma. Inspired by the resilience of widows and guided by mentors including her mother, Dianah Kamande, and global advocates like Heather Ibrahim-Leathers, Praise continues to champion safe spaces, healing, and empowerment for vulnerable communities.

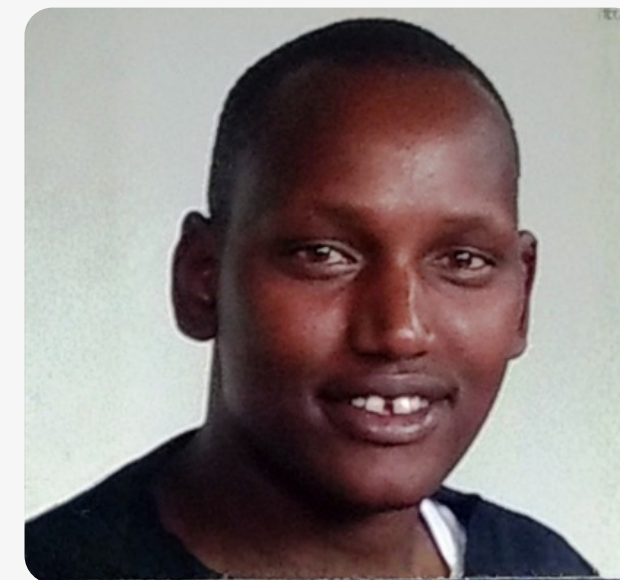
