

HOW TO LEAD A PRAYER WALK

Why a prayer walk?

We are sent as disciples to a specific place and people. We want to partner with what God is already doing and combat spiritual darkness.

Where do I prayer walk?

Wherever represents your mission field best, such as a neighborhood, school, or shopping center. Remember to be a good guest and avoid anything that might be disruptive to those there.

Before you go:

- Spend some time in worship if possible. Pray to be filled with the Spirit and ask God to give you His heart for this place.
- Have a time of silent listening, asking God for any words or pictures that will give direction. He may bring a word, picture or verse pertaining to a person or place to focus on.
- Break up into pairs and go in different directions. Set a time to reconvene. 30 minutes is a good place to start.

As you go:

- Pray audibly as you are led but talk normally as though you are having a conversation.
- Listen as much as you talk. Let the Spirit reveal what God is up to here.
- Pray blessings over the area and against spiritual opposition.
- Pray for salvations and for change that is needed.
- Greet those you see. Be ready to stop to talk—maybe a new relationship will form!

Afterwards:

- Debrief and ask the group what they heard. What do we sense God is doing? What action might He be calling us to take to bring His kingdom to this place?
- Make 'I Will' Statements and action steps.
