## Florida Energy Code Blower Door Preparation Checklist

## **Required Before Scheduling Test**

Power and Access
☐ Permanent power is active (no temporary generators)
☐ Attic hatch cut to fit and installed
$\square$ All exterior doors and windows installed and operable
☐ Exterior door hardware installed (knobs/locks)
☐ Paint/stain on exterior doors is dry
$\square$ Weather stripping installed on all exterior doors, including mechanical closets
Interior Construction
☐ All ceiling finishes and flooring installed
$\square$ All wall and ceiling penetrations sealed (outlets, switches, etc.)
☐ Outlet and low-voltage cover plates installed
$\square$ Recessed lighting, ceiling speakers, and HVAC registers fully installed
$\square$ Kitchen range hood and all exhaust fans installed and operational
☐ Fireplace damper installed and operable (if applicable)
☐ Dryer vent backdraft damper in place (if dryer not installed)
$\square$ No open drywall or ceiling penetrations
HVAC/Volume Info
☐ Air handler installed (does not need startup)
$\square$ Submit energy calculations showing conditioned volume (CF) and floor area (SF)
☐ (Skip submitting energy calculations if Calcs-Plus did them)
On the Day of Testing
☐ Testing takes ~10—15 minutes
$\square$ All exterior doors and windows must remain closed during testing
$\square$ Anyone on-site must stay either inside or outside the home during the test – not move between.
☐ Testing may be rescheduled due to rain or winds over 15 mph
