## 2023 Golf Outing Wrap-up

Al Baker became the seventh Hancock Sports Hall of Fame inductee to be a member of the No.1 team in the seventh Hancock Sports Hall of Fame golf outing held on Friday, June 30, 2023 at Hillcrest Golf Club.

Baker, who was inducted into the county-wide shrine in 2014, was joined on the winning team by

Jill Schmitmeyer, John Beall, Dom Guarnieri and Norm Haynes. Those five posted a 53 in the scramble format, three strokes better than two teams who carded 56s. Jordan Alt, Brandon Baker, Eric Onrus and Tyler Strauer were awarded second on a scorecard playoff over the team of Eric Dysert, Travis Fisher, Anthony Miller and Josh Riedmaier.

The championship team received complimentary golf passes to the Findlay Country Club with \$50 gift certificates from Tony's Restaurant going to the runner-up team and the third-place team receiving gift certificates from Clouse House Golf.

Beall was a member of the top team for the third time after competing on winning squads in 2016 and 2017. He also posted the longest putt of 20 feet on the 18th hole and was awarded a \$100 Clouse House Golf certificate. Jack Winters, a 2003 inductee, sponsored the gift certificate and performed a complimentary putt to show each team the line. Even though his putt did not count, Jack had the longest putt of the day at 24-feet, 2-inches.

Another Hall of Fame inductee from 2014, Bill Kotterman, walked away with a 1s National Bank of Pandora gift basket after recording the longest drive on hole No.7. Russ Wallace, who was a Findlay College baseball player in the early 1970s, claimed a Wildcat Café gift certificate after posting the longest drive on hole No.1.

Along with Baker, Kotterman and Winters 11 other Hall of Fame inductees played in the event, led by 2023 honorees Matt Dodds, Dean Pees and Chuck Radabaugh, along with Ken Brooks ('02), Bob Abbey ('03), Steve Williman ('05), Brad Longberry ('08), Jim Givens (\*12), John Vielhaber ('16), Nate Weihrauch (14) and Chris Miller (\*19).

In all, a record 22 teams participated in the event which raised \$8,125 and will be used to continue the tradition established in 1983 of honoring the county's administrators, coaches, players and teams.
