## Grammar Practice: Modal Verb: “Must” for Obligation

**Rule:** We use **must** to show something is necessary.

- You **must** protect your village.
- Players **must** train troops before battle.



## Comparatives: “-er” / “more” for Comparing Troops

### Rule:

- Add **-er** for short adjectives: *faster, stronger*
- Use **more** for longer ones: *more powerful, more dangerous*

### Examples:

- Barbarians are **stronger** than archers.
- Dragons are **more powerful** than wizards.
