Suzano is proud to announce that it has been selected as a finalist in the Social Impact category at the World Sustainability Awards 2026, one of the most prestigious global recognitions in corporate sustainability.

The shortlisted initiative, Compartilhar Program – Social Impact, has been recognized for its innovative approach to engaging suppliers as a driver of productive inclusion, poverty reduction, and human rights advancement across the value chain.

Through the initiative, Suzano mobilizes suppliers to create employment and income-generation opportunities, support local social projects, and strengthen human rights governance in priority territories. Between 2022 and 2025, suppliers engaged through the program contributed to lifting 13,597 people out of poverty, while mobilizing 25% of Suzano's mapped supplier base.

Being selected as a finalist reflects Suzano's commitment to creating shared value and generating positive social impact beyond its operations. The initiative demonstrates how supplier engagement can help address social inequalities, strengthen human rights protection, and contribute to the company's goal of helping lift 200,000 people out of poverty by 2030.
