Support of Fallen Officers

The RPOF organized the Stand with Seth fundraiser to assist Redlands Police Officer Seth Franklin battling stage 4 cancer. Seth passed away on April 6th, 2025. His wife and two boys (ages 2 and 5) were left with no ongoing income or benefits. The RPOF was able to raise over \$200,000 to support the family.

The RPOF made donations to the families of San Bernardino County Sheriff's Deputies Andrew Nunez and Hector Cuevas, who were tragically killed in the line of duty in our neighboring communities.
