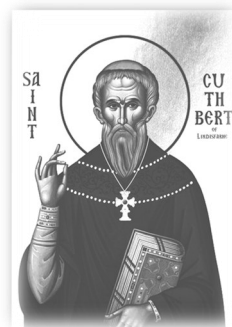

Church Flowers

Very good feedback and suggestions were made at the short meeting held last week. It seems the best way forward is to make the flowers more of a community led thing. So it has been proposed that a 'flower team' is formed and someone has volunteered to lead that and teach others about flower arranging. This will mean that fresh flowers will be arranged by this team for the sanctuary/altar and Our Lady and the Sacred Heart. Some people have volunteered to support this with donations, while other donations will always be welcome. Others have volunteered to look after St Joseph and St Anthony flowers. We will trial this for two months and then review. There was also a lot of suggestions about artificial flowers, and so we will invest in some as a backup and to supplement the fresh flowers.
