

### November: Month of the Holy Souls

November is the beautiful time of year when we have a particular focus of praying for the Holy Souls. Holy Souls Envelopes are now available in church. We will pray for these people at every Mass in November.

### Church Flowers

You may notice some changes in our church flowers - we are using more seasonal and natural materials, often without floral foam or imported flowers. We are working with sustainable floristry principles to reduce waste, use locally grown materials, and celebrate the beauty of creation in a way that cares for the environment. During Advent the church will be decorated with just simple foliage, reflecting the waiting and simplicity of the season. Our flower work room is not safe to work in at the moment but when the building work is finished, we can build a flower team and teach and share sustainable floristry techniques. In the meantime, there will be a large garden container by the back door for any donations of garden foliage we can use — the more variety, the better!
