

A Talk on Pedro Ballester

Pedro's father will be delivering a talk about his son's life, legacy and love of God at the Holy Name Church on Oxford Road on Tuesday 25th November at 6pm. Pedro was born in Manchester in 1996 and was devoted to his lifelong faith instilled first by his parents and then by his time spent as a student living at Opus Dei's Greygarth Hall in Rusholme. He was deeply faithful to his vocation until his untimely death from cancer in 2018 at the age of 21. A cause for sainthood has been opened. St Cuthbert's was his family's parish when they first moved to Manchester.
