

— The Defence Sector is Changing, but Public Markets Can't Access It.

Global defence spend has surged to over \$2.5 trillion, with the sharpest growth in Al, cyber, autonomy, and simulation.

- > Large primes like BAE and Raytheon are diversified and hardware-led.
- Innovators like Anduril and Helsing are private, closed, and venture-backed.
- > ETFs offer broad exposure but no upside leverage.
- The market lacks a focused, high-growth listed vehicle.
- > Europe faces critical dependency on US defence technology, driving urgent demand for sovereign capabilities.
- > European governments are prioritising domestic defence innovation to reduce strategic vulnerability.





— Market Opportunity.

Global defence budgets are expanding at record pace, with Al and cyber now priority spending areas post-Ukraine

The Ministry of Defence has launched the "Engine for Growth" to accelerate sovereign technology development and reduce reliance on foreign suppliers

Allied equivalents (e.g. DIU in the U.S., NATO DIANA, Canadian IDEaS) are reinforcing this push toward localised, agile innovation pipelines

There is now a clear sense of **jeopardy at the door** — both in terms of capability gaps
and digital sovereignty

A strategic inflection point: Western nations are waking up to the reality that their most critical national security infrastructure increasingly runs on foreign-owned code

Defence Holdings is purpose-built to respond to this moment — as a listed, sovereign-aligned platform for critical technology development

The future of UK defence technology shouldn't be private, opaque, or foreign-controlled. It should be sovereign, accountable, and listed.

Public, transparent, and democratically aligned
