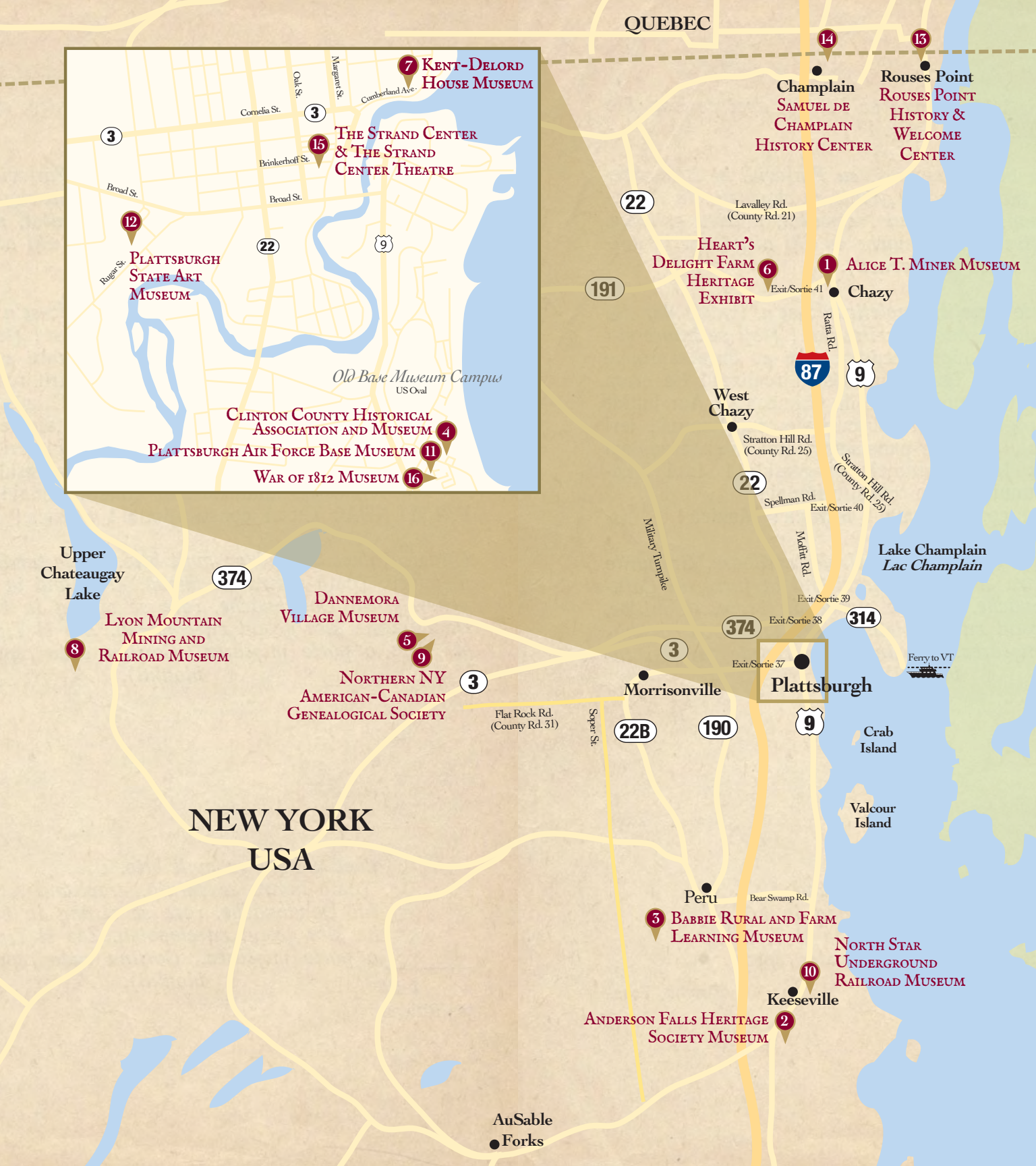

1 Alice T. Miner Museum

This fifteen-room Colonial Revival museum houses Alice T. Miner's collection of furniture, ceramics, glass, samplers, silhouettes, quilts, dolls, and more, most from the 18th and 19th centuries. The museum also displays artifacts related to Alice and William Miner's life and philanthropic work in the North Country.

2 Anderson Falls Heritage House Museum

Selected collection materials include: Clintonville iron industry, Ausable Horse Nail Company, Peanut Railroad, Keeseville Mineral Springs, Keeseville High School yearbooks, history of Keeseville bridges, churches. Research resources: maps, Essex County Republican newspaper, cemetery records, family histories, military and vital records. Docent-guided tours average 30-45 minutes. Access to the museum and exhibits is stair-free; service dogs welcome.

Les matériaux de collection sélectionnés proviennent de : l'industrie du fer de Clintonville, la société Ausable Horse Nail, le chemin de fer Peanut Railroad, les sources minérales de Keeseville, les annuaires du lycée de Keeseville, l'histoire des ponts de Keeseville et les églises de la région. 3 Babbie Rural and Farm Learning Museum

Live the heritage of the Adirondacks as you journey into the past at the Babbie Rural & Farm Learning Museum. Make it an adventure for the whole family as you experience how people lived from the 1800s to the mid-1900s. This museum consists of 17 display buildings resting on 3 picturesque acres. The Museum also offers a “Step Back in Time” tour—a guided private tour for parties of 5 or more during the months of May through October.

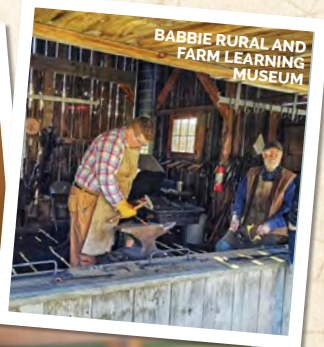

4 Clinton County Historical Association and Museum

Open year-round and located on Old Base Museum Campus, the museum houses more than 50,000 artifacts, photographs, and documents. Galleries include Business and Industry, Redford Glass, and “The Honor of Your Presence,” featuring wedding gowns from the collection. Discover Lake Champlain’s military history timeline with the Aikin rifle and Arto Monaco’s diorama of the Battles of Valcour and Plattsburgh, plus a two-room exhibit on the American Revolution’s Battle of Valcour Island, the Royal Savage gun carriage, Spitfire research, and stories of Indigenous, Women, and Black Patriots. Researchers are welcome. The museum shop offers unique gifts and the area’s largest selection of new and used county history books. Join us in commemorating the 250th anniversary of the Declaration of Independence – 1776-2026.

Ouvert toute l'année, le musée abrite plus de 50 000 artefacts, photographies et documents. Les galeries incluent Business and Industry, Redford Glass et « The Honor of Your Presence », présentant des robes de mariée issues de la collection. Découvrez la chronologie de l'histoire militaire du lac Champlain avec le fusil Aikin et le diorama d'Arto Monaco représentant les batailles de Valcour et de Plattsburgh, ainsi qu'une exposition en deux salles consacrées à la bataille de Valcour Island pendant la Révolution américaine, l'affût du Royal Savage, les recherches sur les Spitfire, ainsi que des récits de peuples autochtones, de femmes et de personnes noires ayant combattu noirs. 5 Dannemora Village Museum

With dioramas of the Clinton Correctional Facility, a 1933 barber's chair, local Native American artifacts, a restored ice harvesting machine and early large fire extinguisher, as well as an early school and education display, a photo display of historic lodging properties and a full DVD collection of the Clayburg Mines, Seneca Ray Stoddard, Arrowheads, Last Maine Logging, Trains and Local Glass Negative Slide Show, Dannemora Village Museum tells the story of the early years of Dannemora, NY.

Le musée possède des dioramas du Clinton Correctional Facility, un fauteuil de barbier datant de 1933, des objets autochtones authentiques locaux, une machine à glace restaurée et un immense extincteur d'incendie. 8 Lyon Mountain Mining and Railroad Museum

Explore the Lyon Mountain Mining and Railroad Museum's captivating exhibits. Discover the inner workings of the mines through photos highlighting occupations and 1957 salaries. Dive into the milling and forging of iron ore with a 36-inch model of the Standish blast furnace. Uncover Standish's history as the iron industry hub, featuring artifacts, photos dating back to 1881, and the 1890 bell from St. Michael's Church. See the original 1936 Iron Shoes Bobsled, designed and fabricated in the Lyon Mountain and Standish mining operations.

Explorez les expositions captivantes du musée de la mine et du chemin de fer de Lyon Mountain. Découvrez le fonctionnement interne des mines à travers des photographies mettant en valeur les métiers et les salaires de 1957. 10 North Star Underground Railroad Museum

North Star Underground Railroad Museum shares powerful stories of freedom along the Upper Hudson River–Champlain and Canal–Lake Champlain corridor of northeastern New York. Through compelling exhibits, the museum highlights the journeys of formerly enslaved individuals, Chinese Americans, and immigrants—past and present—who sought safety and opportunity along this historic route. Visitors can now explore bilingual exhibits in both French and English.

12 Plattsburgh State Art Museum at SUNY Plattsburgh

With a year-round lineup of exhibitions, the museum brings together contemporary artists, student work, traveling shows, and a permanent collection of over 11,000 pieces—creating a space where art sparks curiosity, fuels learning, and connects campus with the wider community through workshops and partnerships. Highlights include the Nina Winkel Courtyard and the Rockwell Kent Gallery in Feinberg Library, home to the nation's most comprehensive collection of Rockwell Kent's work.

13 Rouses Point History and Welcome Center


The Rouses Point History and Welcome Center, located in the renovated former Delaware and Hudson Railroad Station owned by the Village of Rouses Point, is a beautiful 1889 building. It houses exhibits on the D & H Railroad, Ayerst, Wyeth, Pfizer, and local history, including displays on Fort Montgomery and businesses, churches, and organizations throughout Rouses Point's history. This collection includes pictures, ledgers, invoices, business cards, and descriptions of establishments spanning from the late 1700s to the 1900s.
