You must use **Do** and **Does** to help form Yes/No Questions with Regular Verbs.

- *I work every day.*
- **Do** you work every day?

- *He works every day.*
- **Does** he work every day? (Notice the -s on works moves to does.)

- *They work every day.*
- **Do** they work every day?
