Structure:

Am I right?

Yes, you are. / No, you aren't. / No, you're not.

Are you a teacher?

Yes, I am. / No, I'm not.

Is he a student?

Yes, he is. / No, he isn't. / No, he's not.

Are we ready?

Yes, we are. / No, we aren't. / No, we're not.

Are they in the room?

Yes, they are. / No, they aren't. / No, they're not.
