Notice the changes in structure from singular to plural.

Singular	Plural
I am a teacher.	We are teachers s .
You are a teacher.	You are teachers s .
He/She is a teacher.	They are teachers s .
It is a rose.	They are roses s .

I am a teacher.	Mary and I are teachers s .
Mary is a teacher.	Mary and John are teachers s .
