- University of California variety
 - Day neutral
 - Consistently large to very large fruit, red colour with red flesh
 - Outstanding flavour
 - Firm. Shape mostly conic, can be very long and pointed.
 - Moderate yielding
 - Strong but squat growing plant

Strong points Outstanding flavour

- Weak points**
- Susceptible to rain damage especially after an extended dry spell. Produces numerous runners throughout season.
 - More mite and botrytis susceptible.
 - Less productive than other Day Neutral types

Yield in NZ trials Average annual production in the Canterbury trial plots over the past 14 years has been 526 g/plant with berry size 24 g/fruit
