

- Description**
- University of California variety
 - Day-neutral
 - Medium sized plant
 - More productive than Albion, slightly less firm
 - Fruit is, on average, larger than Albion.
 - Medium red skin colour with good appearance.
 - Excellent flavour

Strong points Monterey has become the industry standard day neutral against which new introductions are measured

- Weak points**
- Makes plentiful runners in the fruiting beds
 - Moderately susceptible to root rots including *Phytophthora* and *Verticillium*

Yield in NZ trials Average annual production in the Auckland trial plots (through December) over the past 12 years has been 506 g/plant with berry size 27 g/fruit - data applicable up until late December. In Canterbury average yield has been 729 g/plant with average berry size of 22g/fruit
