

Description	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• University of California variety• Day neutral• Highly productive• Small to medium sized plant• Fruit size is similar to Albion• Medium to dark red skin colour with excellent appearance and good firmness
Strong points	Good tolerance to rain and weather damage Good tolerance to two spotted mites
Weak points	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Susceptible to <i>Phytophthora</i> root rot and <i>Verticillium</i>• Requires specific nutrition program to ensure good flavour
Yield in NZ trials	Average annual production in the Auckland trial plots (through December) over the past 5 years has been 487 g/plant with berry size 27 g/fruit. In Canterbury average yield has been 893 g/plant with average berry size of 24g/fruit
