- University of California variety
- Short-day type
- Smaller sized plant
- Very productive with excellent appearance.
- Fruit size is very large
- Medium red skin colour with excellent appearance and good firmness
- Excellent flavour
- Very good resistance to fruit damage in wet weather
- High level of resistance to *Phytophthora* root rot and *Verticillium*

## Strong points

Consistently large to very large fruit size, with good root rot disease resistance.

Yield in NZ Average annual production in the Auckland trial plots (through December) over the past 4 years has been 667 g/plant with berry size 29 g/fruit.
