- University of California variety
 - Short-day type
 - Smaller sized plant
 - Very productive with excellent appearance.
 - Fruit size is very large
 - Medium red skin colour with excellent appearance and good firmness
 - Excellent flavour
 - Very good resistance to fruit damage in wet weather
 - High level of resistance to *Phytophthora* root rot and *Verticillium*

Strong points Consistently large to very large fruit size, with good root rot disease resistance.

Weak points • No obvious weaknesses

Yield in NZ trials Average annual production in the Auckland trial plots (through December) over the past 4 years has been 667 g/plant with berry size 29 g/fruit.
