

<b>Description</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• University of California variety</li><li>• Short-day</li><li>• Medium–dark red fruit.</li><li>• Consistently large to very large fruit size. Firm, shiny and consistently conical fruit.</li><li>• Flavour very good.</li><li>• Yield is very good.</li><li>• Good resistance to wet weather.</li><li>• Plants are vigorous and plant spacing should be wide enough to allow air movement around the plants at least 200mm to 250mm between plants.</li></ul>
<b>Strong points</b>	Good tolerance to rain and weather damage
<b>Weak points</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Flavour can be poor early season and size can drop late season.</li><li>• Subject to post harvest rots especially if grown too close and not clean harvested regularly.</li><li>• Vigorous plant not well suited to table-top growing systems</li></ul>
<b>Yield in NZ trials</b>	Average annual production in the Auckland trial plots (through December) over the past 19 years has been 770 g/plant with berry size 21 g/fruit planted at either 200 or 250mm apart.
