

- Description**
- University of California variety
 - Day-neutral
 - Yield is early and high
 - Very large red fruit produced on large plant.
 - Flesh medium red and firm
 - Flavour is very good
 - Very good resistance to fruit damage in wet weather

Strong points Consistently large to very large fruit size, and early yield.

- Weak points**
- Moderately susceptible to root rots
 - Large plant size might present challenges in tabletop situation

Yield in NZ trials Average annual production in the Auckland trial plots (through December) over the past 4 years has been 624 g/plant with average berry size of 31 g/fruit up to Xmas. In Canterbury, average production over the past 2 years has been 996g with an average berry size of 29g.
