Description

- University of California variety
- Day-neutral
- Small to medium sized plant
- Highly productive
- Fruit size is very large
- Medium red skin colour with excellent appearance and good firmness.
- Good tolerance to rain and weather damage.

Strong points High yielding, with large fruit size that is maintained for a long season. Very large size may provide specialist sales opportunities.

Weak points

Poor runner producer which is good for fruit growers but is difficult for plant producers to grow economically. Runner production from tissue culture mothers is acceptable, so plug production is available.

Yield in NZ Average annual production in the Auckland trial plots (through trials December) over the past 3 years has been 450 g/plant with berry size 31 g/fruit - data applicable up until late December. In Canterbury average yield has been 1030 g/plant with average berry size of 29g/fruit
