- University of California variety
 - Day-neutral
 - Highly productive
 - Medium sized plant
 - Fruit size is large
 - Medium red skin colour with excellent appearance and good firmness
 - Fruit shape can be highly variable
 - Good tolerance to rain and weather damage
- Strong points** Has performed well in winter production trials (indoors) in Canterbury
- Weak points**
- Variable fruit production sequence—peaks followed by period of little or no fruit production
- Yield in NZ trials** For the past 3 years, average annual production in the Auckland trial plots (through December) has been 492 g/plant with berry size 26 g/fruit - data applicable up until late December. In Canterbury average yield has been 783 g/plant with average berry size of 25g/fruit
