

- Description**
- University of California variety
 - Short-day type
 - Smaller sized plant
 - Very productive with excellent appearance and good firmness
 - Fruit size is very large
 - Medium red skin colour with excellent appearance and good firmness
 - Excellent flavour
 - Very good resistance to fruit damage in wet weather
 - High level of resistance to *Phytophthora* root rot

Strong points Consistently large fruit size.

- Weak points**
- More susceptible than other varieties to leaf blotch
 - Not better than Victor

Yield in NZ trials Average annual production in the Auckland trial plots (through December) over the past 4 years has been 527 g/plant with berry size 26 g/fruit.
