Kubuswoningen

The Cube Houses (or Pole Houses or Tree Houses) designed by architect Piet Blom are part of the Blaakse Bos development which borders on the Laurenskwartier district and the Waterfront area. The KijkKubus (Show-Cube) is a furnished museum house, specially designed and constructed to let the visitor experience what life is like in a Cube House. The Kijk-Kubus is open seven days a week from 11:00 a.m. to 17:00 p.m. The Kijk-Kubus can be reached by tram, metro and bus. Blaak metro station is right outside the door and there are three parking garages in the immediate vicinity.

Markthal Rotterdam

You'll find an indoor market hall in various world-class cities, but the combination with luxury housing makes Rotterdam's Markthal the first of its kind. As you wander amongst the at least 100 market stands, look up to enjoy the massive artwork sprawling across the ceiling: the 'Horn of Plenty' by Arno Coenen and Iris Roskam. Thanks to this grand span of art, the Markthal has been referred to as the Dutch version of the Sistine Chapel. The Markthal is open seven days a week until 20.00. Visitors can sign up for an Open Tour on the weekend via De Rotterdam Tours : a one-hour tour of the Markthal.



Depot Boijmans van Beuningen

Depot Boijmans Van Beuningen is one of the oldest museums in the Netherlands. The collection includes paintings, sculptures and objects, as well as an important collection of drawings and etchings. It features many major Dutch and European works spanning the period from the early middle ages to the 21st century, from Van Bosch to Rembrandt, and from Van Gogh to Dalí and Dutch Design. Depot Boijmans Van Beuningen is located in the Museumkwartier district.

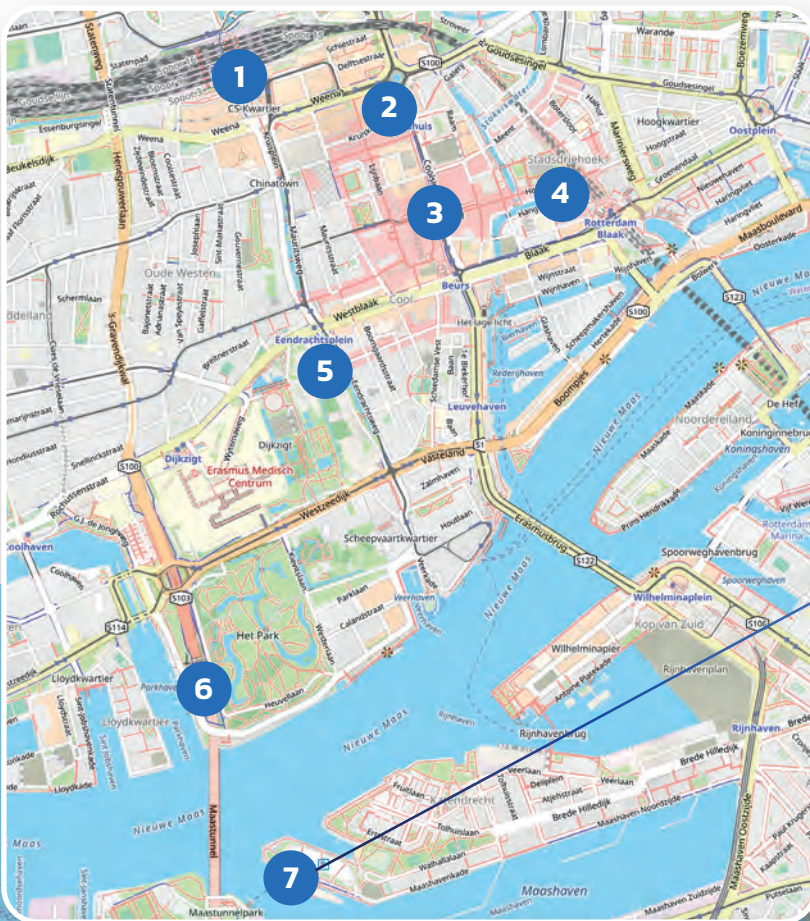

SS Rotterdam

a proud Dutch icon with a glamorous past

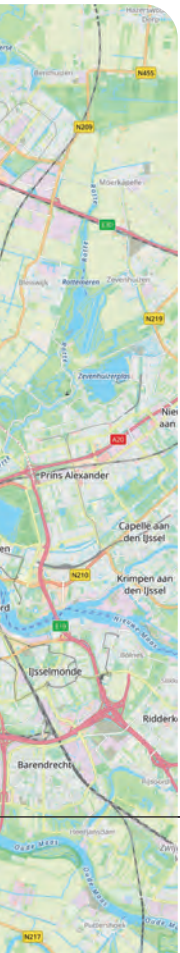
Since 1959, the ss Rotterdam has stood as a symbol of Dutch pride and maritime innovation. Originally designed for transatlantic service between Rotterdam and New York, this revolutionary vessel featured a unique horizontal two-class layout, movable partitions, and a double staircase—making it one of the most advanced ocean liners of its time.

After a decade crossing the Atlantic, the ship transitioned into a luxury cruise liner in 1969, sailing to destinations like the Caribbean, Alaska, and on world cruises, especially popular with wealthy American travelers. In 1997, it was renamed SS Rembrandt under new ownership, but soon after was laid up due to the company's financial collapse.

Thanks to the Steamship Rotterdam Foundation, the beloved ship was rescued and fully restored. In 2008, she triumphantly returned to her home port of Rotterdam. Today, the ss Rotterdam is permanently moored and open to the public as a hotel, restaurant, and museum.

Visitors can explore the original art, machine rooms, passenger decks, captain's quarters, and the bridge. Adding a personal touch, over 200 passionate volunteers—many of them former passengers—share fascinating stories and lead guided tours that bring the ship's rich history to life.

Whether you're onboard for a gala dinner, a night in one of its historic cabins, or simply a tour, the ss Rotterdam offers a one-of-a-kind experience steeped in nautical charm and nostalgia.
