

AEONrv Named No. 66 on the 2026 Inc. 5000, Ranking Among America's Fastest-Growing Private Companies

Reno-based adventure vehicle manufacturer ranks No. 1 in Nevada and No. 2 in Automotive overall after achieving 4,231% three-year revenue growth.



RENO, NV, August 11, 2026 — [AEONrv](#), the Reno-based manufacturer redefining off-road, off-grid recreational vehicles, today announced it has been named No. 66 on the 2026 Inc. 5000, the nation's most prestigious ranking of the fastest-growing private companies. The placement puts AEONrv in the top 1.3% of the 5,000 companies on this year's list.

The company also ranked No. 1 in Nevada, No. 1 in Reno, and No. 2 in the Automotive category, after posting 4,231% revenue growth from 2022 through 2025.

AEONrv has become one of America's fastest-growing manufacturers by rethinking conventional RV design. The company built a new category of adventure vehicle around an all-electric cabin, advanced composite construction with an average insulation value of R-15, intelligent energy systems, and a direct-to-consumer model made for today's off-grid traveler.

"Five years ago, we set out to build an RV from first principles, challenging decades of conventional thinking to create something fundamentally better," said Jim Ritchie, CEO and co-founder of AEONrv. "Ranking No. 66 among the fastest-growing private companies in America validates that vision, but more importantly, it reflects the trust our customers have placed in us. We're incredibly proud of what our team has accomplished, and we're just getting started."

The recognition comes during a period of rapid growth for the company as it expands production, introduces new vehicle platforms, and continues investing in advanced manufacturing in Reno, Nevada.

Building the Next Generation of Adventure Vehicles

AEONrv builds two all-season, off-road adventure vehicles on the Ford Transit AWD chassis, each featuring an all-electric cabin powered by a robust solar and lithium battery system that provides heating, cooling, cooking, hot water, and onboard power without propane or a generator.

New for 2026, every AEONrv features completely wood-free construction, including lightweight PET foam-core cabinetry made from recycled plastic water bottles. The result is a lighter, stronger, and more moisture-resistant vehicle that improves durability, increases payload capacity, and advances the company's commitment to sustainable manufacturing.

The 22-foot AEONrv starts at \$229,500, while the 23-foot 6-inch AEONrv EXT starts at \$239,500, plus options and applicable taxes.

Inc. 5000 List Methodology

Companies on the 2026 Inc. 5000 are ranked according to percentage revenue growth from 2022 to 2025. To qualify, companies must have been founded and generating revenue by March 31, 2022. They must be U.S.-based, privately held, for-profit, and independent (not subsidiaries or divisions of other companies) as of December 31, 2025. (Since then, some on the list may have gone public or been acquired.) The minimum revenue required for 2022 is \$100,000, the minimum for 2025 is \$2 million. As always, Inc. reserves the right to decline applicants for subjective reasons.
